15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
16 entire bill and insert

17 "An Act relating to gaming; creating the Task Force
18 for the Study of Lottery and Gaming Revenues;
19 providing for membership of Task Force; requiring
20 organizational meeting; providing for quorum;
21 requiring study of certain lottery and gaming
22 issues; defining scope of study; providing Task
23 Force subject to certain statutory provisions;
24 providing for staff assistance; requiring final
report; providing for termination of Task Force; and
providing for codification.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

2 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
3 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 100 of Title 3A, unless there is
4 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

5 A. There is hereby created the Task Force for the Study of
6 Lottery and Gaming Revenues.

7 B. The Task Force shall consist of nine (9) members to be
8 appointed or selected as follows:

9 1. Three members to be appointed by the Governor at least one
10 of whom shall be a principal member of the Governor's staff;

11 2. Three members, who shall be members of the Oklahoma House of
12 Representatives, to be appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma
13 House of Representatives; and

14 3. Three members, who shall be members of the Oklahoma State
15 Senate, to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the State
16 Senate.

17 C. The Task Force shall conduct an organizational meeting not
18 later than September 1, 2010. A majority of the members present at
19 the organizational meeting or any subsequent meeting shall
20 constitute a quorum for the purpose of any action taken including
21 the preparation and approval of the final report required by
22 subsection H of this section.

23 D. The Task Force shall be authorized to meet as necessary in
24 order to perform the duties imposed upon it. Legislative members of

1 the Task Force shall be reimbursed for travel expenses pursuant to
2 the provisions of Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
3 Other members of the Task Force shall be reimbursed as provided by
4 the appointing authority.

5 E. The Task Force shall conduct a study reviewing and
6 evaluating lottery and gaming policies in the state and examining
7 lottery and gaming revenues accruing to the state and their impact
8 on the state budget.

9 F. The Task Force shall be subject to the provisions of:

- 10 1. The Oklahoma Open Meeting Act; and
- 11 2. The Oklahoma Open Records Act.

12 G. Staff assistance for the Task Force shall be provided by the
13 staff of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the State Senate.

14 H. The Task Force shall produce a final written report of its
15 findings and any recommendations regarding state law with respect to
16 lottery and gaming. The report shall be submitted to the Governor,
17 the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the
18 President Pro Tempore of the State Senate not later than December
19 31, 2010.

20 I. The provisions of this section shall cease to have the force
21 and effect of law and the Task Force shall terminate effective
22 January 1, 2011."
