14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

16 "An Act relating to state government; amending 74
17 O.S. 2001, Section 8204, which relates to
18 acquisition and development of property; authorizing
the Oklahoma Historical Society to transfer certain
property to certain entities; and declaring an
19 emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 8204, is
23 amended to read as follows:

1 Section 8204. A. The Oklahoma Historical Society is hereby
2 authorized to acquire real property for the site for the location of
3 The 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Memorial of Reconciliation. The site
4 selection shall involve the cooperation of The 1921 Tulsa Race Riot
5 Memorial of Reconciliation Committee. The Except as provided in
6 subsection C of this section, the Society shall assume the
7 performance of all existing and future obligations related to the
8 development, design, operation and maintenance of The 1921 Tulsa
9 Race Riot Memorial of Reconciliation created in Section 8201.1 of
10 ~~Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

11 B. The Except as provided in subsection C of this section, the
12 Society shall hold and use the land transferred to the Oklahoma
13 Historical Society pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of
14 this section for the development, design, construction and operation
15 of The 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Memorial of Reconciliation commemorating
16 the lives of the victims and honoring the survivors of The 1921
17 Tulsa Race Riot. The Society shall erect the memorial pursuant to
18 procedures outlined in Section 8201.1 of ~~Title 74 of the Oklahoma~~
19 ~~Statutes~~ this title.

20 C. Upon the effective date of this act, the Society may
21 transfer all duties and obligations pursuant to subsections A and B
22 of this section, except for those duties and obligations outlined in
23 Section 8201.1 of this title, to the municipal governing body or a

1 public trust of the municipal governing body where The 1921 Tulsa
2 Race Riot Memorial of Reconciliation is located.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
