AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

"An Act relating to cities and towns; stating
legislative findings; providing for the expenditure
of funds by certain entities for certain customers
for energy conservation activities; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 35-206 of Title 11, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The Oklahoma State Legislature hereby determines that
2 expenditures of funds for the purposes of the conservation of
3 electricity or natural gas by public agencies is in the public
4 interest. In furtherance of this public interest, municipally owned
5 utilities or public trusts thereof or the Grand River Dam Authority
6 may expend, with governing board approval, funds to assist consumers
7 in the establishment of energy conservation activities if there is a
8 defined and measurable conservation of energy. The expenditures may
9 be made subsequent to achievement of measures outlined in an energy
10 audit or an engineering audit of the consumer's operations.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009."
