21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 160.3 of Title 62, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
2 for the Office of the State Treasurer to be designated the "Oklahoma
3 Centennial Botanical Garden Authority Revolving Fund". The fund
4 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,
5 and shall consist of all monies accruing to the Authority by
6 appropriation and Oklahoma Centennial Botanical Garden operations.
7 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
8 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office of the
9 State Treasurer for the purpose of further development and operation
10 of the Oklahoma Centennial Botanical Garden. Expenditures from the
11 fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
12 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State
13 Finance for approval and payment. Notwithstanding any other
14 provision of this section to the contrary, no state appropriations
15 shall ever be made to the Oklahoma Centennial Botanical Garden
16 Authority Revolving Fund and the Fund shall not be authorized to
17 receive any deposit of state appropriations for any purpose."
