14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

16 "An Act relating to geologic storage of carbon
dioxide; re-creating the Oklahoma Geologic Storage
17 of Carbon Dioxide Task Force; providing for
termination; providing for continuation of members
18 and duties; stating duties; requiring report by
certain date; stating distribution; providing for
19 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be

24 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

1 A. The Oklahoma Geologic Storage of Carbon Dioxide Task Force
2 created pursuant to Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1765 of the 2nd Session
3 of the 51st Legislature, is hereby re-created to continue until
4 December 1, 2009. The members previously appointed to the task
5 force shall continue to serve with new members appointed as
6 necessary by the original appointing authority pursuant to the
7 provisions of Senate Bill No. 1765. Staffing and travel
8 reimbursement provisions shall remain the same as provided in Senate
9 Bill No. 1765.

10 B. The task force shall continue to study any issues necessary
11 to implement the transmission and storage of carbon dioxide in
12 geologic formations, including, but not limited to, insurance,
13 liability and ownership issues relating to long-term carbon dioxide
14 storage facilities and the task force shall make a report which may
15 include legislative recommendations following the termination of its
16 activities. Such report shall be distributed to the Governor, the
17 President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
18 Representatives no later than December 15, 2009.

19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
