14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill
and insert

17 "An Act relating to state government; amending 74
18 O.S. 2001, Section 590, which relates to prohibition
of employment of a state officer; providing for
19 penalty; and providing an effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 590, is
23 amended to read as follows:

1 Section 590. A. Any state officer or employee who exercises
2 discretionary or decision-making authority in awarding a
3 privatization contract shall be prohibited for a period of one (1)
4 year from the date that the privatization contract is awarded from
5 becoming an officer or employee of a business organization which is
6 a party to any privatization contract with the state agency in which
7 the state officer or employee exercised such discretionary or
8 decision-making authority.

9 B. In the event of a violation of the provisions of subsection
10 A of this section, the business organization shall be prohibited,
11 for a period of one (1) year from the date of the violation, from
12 contracting with the state agency in which the state officer or
13 state employee exercised discretionary or decision-making authority.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009."
