23 permanent markers; designating the TSGT Jason Norton  
24 Memorial Bridge; providing for permanent markers;  
designating the Commissioner Jimmie Primrose Memorial  
Bridge; providing for permanent markers; designating  
the SSGT Larry S. Pierce Memorial Highway; providing  
for permanent markers; designating the Sheriff Jerry  
Beall and Police Chief Joe Rowden Memorial Highway;  
providing for permanent markers; designating the  
Mazzebeth Turner Memorial Highway; providing for

1 permanent markers; designating the U.S. Army 509th  
2 Engineer Company Memorial Bridge; providing for  
3 permanent markers; designating the U.S. Army Staff  
4 Sgt. Brandon W. Farley Memorial Highway; providing  
5 for permanent markers; designating the Charles  
6 "Choppy" Parker Memorial Bridge; providing for  
7 permanent markers; designating the Leon Sherrer  
8 Highway; providing for permanent markers; designating  
9 the Deputy Sheriff Dustin Duncan Memorial Bridge;  
10 providing for permanent markers; designating the U.S.  
11 Army, 2nd Lieutenant Fred Sonaggera Memorial Bridge;  
12 providing for permanent markers; providing for  
13 codification; and declaring an emergency.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.43 of Title 69, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 32 from Interstate 35 west to the  
Jefferson County Line shall be designated as the "State  
Representative Terry Hyman Memorial Highway". The Department of  
Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed  
on the highway bearing that name.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.44 of Title 69, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 63 from Kiowa, Oklahoma, extending  
east approximately three (3) miles to Pittsburg, Oklahoma, shall be  
designated as the "Carsyn Kay Hackler Memorial Highway". The

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
2 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.45 of Title 69, unless  
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge in Pontotoc County on State Highway 48 approximately  
7 five (5) miles south of Allen, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the  
8 "M/SGT Ura M. Horton Memorial Bridge". The Department of  
9 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed  
10 on the bridge bearing that name.

11 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.46 of Title 69, unless  
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The bridge that crosses the Neosho River on State Highway 125 at  
15 Riverview Park in Miami, Oklahoma, shall be designated the "TSGT  
16 Jason Norton Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation  
17 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge  
18 bearing that name.

19 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.47 of Title 69, unless  
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge in Murray County that crosses the Washita River on  
23 State Highway 7 between Interstate 35 and Davis, Oklahoma, shall be  
24 designated the "Commissioner Jimmie Primrose Memorial Bridge". The

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
2 to be placed on the bridge bearing that name.

3 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.48 of Title 69, unless  
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The portion of U.S. Highway 270 between Seminole, Oklahoma, and  
7 Wewoka, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "SSGT Larry S. Pierce  
8 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
9 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that  
10 name.

11 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.49 of Title 69, unless  
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of State Highway 51 in Payne County that is between  
15 the junctions of State Highway 108 with State Highway 51 shall be  
16 designated as the "Sheriff Jerry Beall and Police Chief Joe Rowden  
17 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
18 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that  
19 name.

20 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.50 of Title 69, unless  
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The portion of State Highway 77 in Murray County that is between  
24 the junctions of State Highway 77 and Interstate 35 at exits 51 and

1 47 shall be designated as the "Mazzebeth Turner Memorial Highway".  
2 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent  
3 markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

4 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.51 of Title 69, unless  
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The bridge in Oklahoma County on State Highway 4 approximately  
8 one (1) mile north of the junction of State Highway 4 with State  
9 Highway 3 shall be designated as the "U.S. Army 509th Engineer  
10 Company Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall  
11 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing  
12 that name.

13 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.52 of Title 69, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The portion of State Highway 3 east of Idabel to Tom shall be  
17 designated as the "U.S. Army Staff Sgt. Brandon W. Farley Memorial  
18 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
19 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

20 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.53 of Title 69, unless  
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge on State Highway 11 in Alfalfa County crossing the  
24 Salt Fork River shall be designated as the "Charles "Choppy" Parker

1 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
2 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing that  
3 name.

4 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.54 of Title 69, unless  
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The Business portion where State Highways 69 and 75 are one  
8 common merged highway in Bryan County from the intersection of  
9 Waldon Drive and State Highway 69 north to Alabama Street in Durant,  
10 shall be designated the "Leon Sherrer Highway". The Department of  
11 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed  
12 on the highway bearing that name.

13 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.55 of Title 69, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The bridge on State Highway 112 crossing the Poteau River in  
17 LeFlore County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sheriff Dustin  
18 Duncan Memorial Bridge" and the Department of Transportation shall  
19 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on that bridge.

20 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.56 of Title 69, unless  
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge on State Highway 128 east of Heavner in LeFlore  
24 County shall be designated as the "U.S. Army, 2nd Lieutenant Fred
