12 Section 1, Chapter 244, O.S.L. 2006 (21 O.S. Supp.
13 2009, Section 1380), which relates to the Oklahoma
14 Funeral Picketing Act; modifying purpose and scope of
certain prohibited act; clarifying certain
definition; increasing penalties; and providing an
effective date.

18 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 4, lines 1 through 6, delete
19 subsection F and insert a new subsection F
20 to read

21 "F. Notwithstanding the penalties provided in
22 subsection E of this section, any district court may enjoin
23 conduct proscribed by this section and may in any such
24 proceeding award punitive damages. ~~, including punitive
damages,~~ Additionally, any district court shall assess

1 attorney fees, court costs, other costs associated with
2 holding a protest, or other appropriate relief against the
3 person or persons found guilty of actions made unlawful by
4 this section."

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 4, line 6 1/2, insert a new subsection
6 G to read

7 "G. A person or organization violating any provision of the
8 Oklahoma Funeral Picketing Act shall not have any cause of action
9 against a parent, spouse, sibling or child of any deceased
10 individual for any act committed under emotional distress and in
11 response to such violation during the time period prescribed by this
12 act."

13 AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 4, line 7, delete Section 2 and insert
14 a new Section 2 to read

15 "SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 1, strike the title to read

20 "[crimes and punishments - Funeral Picketing Act -
21 modifying purpose - clarifying definition -
22 increasing penalties -
23 emergency]"

24 and when the title is restored amend the title to conform
