AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause
and entire bill and insert

25 "An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
26 designating the Master Sergeant Houston K. Blackburn
27 Memorial Highway; designating the PFC Lonnie D. Loyd,
28 Jr. Memorial Highway; designating the George Freas
29 Memorial Bridge; designating the Fallen Heroes
30 Memorial Bridge; designating the 95th Division
31 Memorial Highway; designating the E. A. Woods
32 Memorial Highway; designating the Representative Opio
33 Toure Memorial Highway; designating the USMC Cpl.

1 Jeremy D. Allbaugh Memorial Highway; designating the
2 James W. Summerlin Memorial Highway; designating the
3 Walter Merrick Memorial Highway; designating the
4 Raymond Mallouf Memorial Highway; designating the
5 Frank Drew Memorial Bridge; designating the Dr. D.P.
6 Richardson, M.D. Memorial Highway; designating the
7 E.F. (Doc) Coker Bridge; providing for placement of
8 permanent markers; providing for codification; and
9 declaring an emergency.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.60 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 That portion of State Highway 7 from the Atoka city limits
15 extending west to the Johnston County line shall be designated as
16 the "Master Sergeant Houston K. Blackburn Memorial Highway". The
17 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
18 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

19 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.61 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 That portion of State Highway 48 from the junction of State
23 Highway 48 and State Highway 7 extending north to the Johnston
24 County line shall be designated as the "PFC Lonnie D. Loyd, Jr.
Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
name.

1 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.62 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge on State Highway 31 approximately four (4) miles
5 southwest of Ashland in Coal County shall be designated the "George
6 Freas Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
7 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing
8 that name.

9 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.63 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The bridge crossing Bull Creek on East State Highway 60
13 approximately one (1) mile east of the junction of East State
14 Highway 60 and State Highway 2 in Craig County shall be designated
15 the "Fallen Heroes Memorial Bridge". The Department of
16 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
17 on the bridge bearing that name.

18 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.64 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 That portion of Interstate 44 located in Comanche County from
22 the junction of Interstate 44 and State Highway 7 extending north to
23 mile marker 46 shall be designated as the "95th Division Memorial
24

1 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
2 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.65 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The portion of State Highway 46 from the junction of State
7 Highway 46 and State Highway 15 extending south to the junction of
8 State Highway 46 and the Sharon-Shattuck Road shall be designated as
9 the "E.A. Woods Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
10 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway
11 bearing that name.

12 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.66 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The portion of Interstate 35 in Oklahoma City between Northeast
16 23rd Street and Interstate 40 shall be designated as the
17 "Representative Opio Toure Memorial Highway". The Department of
18 Transportation shall place suitable permanent markers on the highway
19 bearing that name.

20 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.67 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The portion of State Highway 11 in Blackwell between Interstate
24 35 and 13th Street shall be designated as the "USMC Cpl. Jeremy D.

1 Allbaugh Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
2 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing
3 that name.

4 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.68 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The portion of State Highway 88 between Inola and Claremore
8 shall be designated the "James W. Summerlin Memorial Highway". The
9 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
10 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

11 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.69 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of State Highway 66 from the I-40 loop at exit 25 to
15 4th street in Sayre shall be designated as the "Walter Merrick
16 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
17 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing
18 that name.

19 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.70 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The portion of State Highway 152 from the I-40 loop at exit 23
23 to 3rd Street in Sayre shall be designated as the "Raymond Mallouf
24 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause

1 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing
2 that name.

3 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.71 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge on United States Highway 81 crossing the Canadian
7 River between Union City and Minco shall be designated the "Frank
8 Drew Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
9 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that
10 name.

11 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.72 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of United States Highway 81 beginning and ending
15 with the city limits of Union City shall be designated as the "Dr.
16 D.P. Richardson, M.D. Memorial Highway". The Department of
17 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
18 upon the highway bearing that name.

19 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.73 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge on State Highway 63, crossing Ti Creek, in Pittsburg
23 County shall be designated the "E.F. (Doc) Coker Bridge". The
