8 An Act relating to consolidation of state agencies;  
transferring certain powers and duties of the Scenic  
9 Rivers Commission to the Oklahoma Tourism and  
Recreation Commission; specifying the transfer of  
10 certain property, assets, liabilities, fund balance,  
and obligations; defining the jurisdictional area of  
11 the Scenic Rivers Commission; \*\*\*\*\* providing for  
the transfer of monies accruing after a certain date;  
12 providing for succession of contractual rights;  
providing for the enforcement of certain rules by the  
13 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission; \*\*\*\*\*  
amending 82 O.S. 2001, Sections 1454, 1457, as  
14 amended by Section 1, Chapter 148, O.S.L. 2002, 1458,  
1462C, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 192, O.S.L.  
15 2003, 1464, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 305,  
O.S.L. 2003, 1466 and 1470, as last amended by  
16 Section 2, Chapter 301, O.S.L. 2008 (82 O.S. Supp.  
2009, Sections 1457, 1462C, 1464 and 1470), which  
17 relate to the Scenic Rivers Act; \*\*\*\*\* clarifying  
statutory language; repealing 82 O.S. 2001, Sections  
18 1460, 1461, \*\*\*\*\* 2003 (82 O.S. Supp. 2009,  
Sections 1461, 1462A, 1462B, 1463 and 1469), which  
19 relate to the Scenic Rivers Act; providing for  
codification; providing an effective date; and  
20 declaring an emergency.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

7 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9500 of Title 74, unless there  
9 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 A. Chapter 95 of Title 74 shall be known and cited as the  
11 "Oklahoma Department of Natural Resources Code".

12 B. All statutes hereinafter enacted and codified in Chapter 95  
13 of this title shall be considered and deemed part of the Oklahoma  
14 Department of Natural Resources Code.

15 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9501 of Title 74, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The following agencies, boards, and commissions and their  
19 appropriated funds shall be merged together and become the Oklahoma  
20 Department of Natural Resources:

- 21 1. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry;
- 22 2. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce;
- 23 3. The Oklahoma Conservation Commission;
- 24 4. Consumer on Consumer Credit;

- 1 5. The Corporation Commission;
  - 2 6. The Department of Environmental Quality;
  - 3 7. The Oklahoma Historical Society;
  - 4 8. The Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission;
  - 5 9. The Insurance Department;
  - 6 10. The Department of Labor;
  - 7 11. The J.M. Davis Memorial Commission;
  - 8 12. The Department of Mines;
  - 9 13. The Scenic Rivers Commission;
  - 10 14. The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department;
  - 11 15. The Oklahoma Water Resources Board; and
  - 12 16. The Will Rogers Memorial Commission.
- 13 B. The following non-appropriated agencies, boards, and
- 14 commissions shall be merged into the Oklahoma Department of Natural
- 15 Resources:
- 16 1. The Department of Wildlife Conservation;
  - 17 2. The Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board;
  - 18 3. The Oklahoma Employees Securities Commission;
  - 19 4. The Grand River Dam Authority;
  - 20 5. The Oklahoma State Banking Department;
  - 21 6. The Oklahoma Clean Energy Independence Commission;
  - 22 7. The Oklahoma Energy Resources Board; and
  - 23 8. The Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells."
