7 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
9 2001, Section 6-115, as last amended by Section 3,
10 Chapter 294, O.S.L. 2006 (47 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section
11 6-115), which relates to the expiration and renewal
12 of driver licenses; authorizing use of certain driver
13 licenses as a valid form of identification; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 6-115, as
17 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 294, O.S.L. 2006 (47 O.S. Supp.
18 2008, Section 6-115), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 6-115. A. Except as otherwise provided in this
20 section, every driver license shall be issued for a period of no
21 more than four (4) years; provided, if the applicant or licensee is
22 an alien, the license shall be issued for a period which does not
23 exceed the lesser of:

- 24 1. Four (4) years; or

1 2. The expiration date on the valid documentation authorizing
2 the presence of the applicant or licensee in the United States, as
3 required by paragraph 9 of subsection A of Section 6-103 of this
4 title.

5 B. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the expiration
6 date of an initial license shall be no more than four (4) years from
7 the last day of the month of issuance or no more than four (4) years
8 from the last day of the birth month of the applicant immediately
9 preceding the date of issuance, if requested by the applicant.

10 C. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the expiration
11 date of a renewal license shall be no more than four (4) years from
12 the last day of the month of expiration of the previous license or
13 no more than four (4) years from the last day of the birth month of
14 the licensee immediately preceding the expiration date of the
15 previous license, if requested by the licensee.

16 D. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection E of Section
17 1550.42 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, any Oklahoma driver
18 license that is not more than thirty (30) days past the date of
19 expiration provided on the driver license shall be presumed to be a
20 valid form of identification for the purposes of renewing an
21 Oklahoma driver license.

22 E. Except as otherwise provided in this section, every driver
23 license shall be renewable by the licensee upon application to
24 either the Department of Public Safety or a motor license agent,

1 furnishing both primary and secondary proofs of identity, the
2 current mailing address of the person and payment of the required
3 fee, if the person is otherwise eligible for renewal. If the
4 licensee is an alien, the licensee shall appear before a driver
5 license examiner of the Department and, after furnishing primary and
6 secondary proofs of identity as required in this section, shall be
7 issued a renewal driver license for a period which does not exceed
8 the lesser of:

9 1. Four (4) years; or

10 2. The expiration date on the valid documentation authorizing
11 the presence of the applicant or licensee in the United States, as
12 required by paragraph 9 of subsection A of Section 6-103 of this
13 title.

14 ~~E.~~ F. All applicants for renewals of driver licenses who have
15 proven collision records or apparent physical defects may be
16 required to take an examination as specified by the Commissioner of
17 Public Safety.

18 ~~F.~~ G. When a person makes application for a driver license, or
19 makes application to renew a driver license, and the person has been
20 convicted of, or received a deferred judgment for, any offense
21 required to register pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act,
22 the driver license shall be valid for a period of one (1) year from
23 the month of issuance, but may be renewed yearly during the time the
24 person is registered on the Sex Offender Registry. The cost for

1 such license shall be the same as for other driver licenses and
2 renewals.

3 G. H. The Department of Public Safety shall promulgate rules
4 prescribing forms of primary and secondary identification acceptable
5 for the renewal of an Oklahoma driver license.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
