8 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.  
9 2001, Section 3921, which relates to the termination  
10 of certain entities; providing for termination of  
11 task forces or similar advisory entities; prescribing  
12 time period for termination; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3921, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 3921. A. 1. Any joint resolution or bill enacted  
18 after February 1, 1993, creating or establishing advisory bodies  
19 including, but not limited to, task forces, boards, commissions, and  
20 councils, which creation or establishment is not codified in the  
21 Oklahoma Statutes, shall terminate the first day of the first  
22 regular session of the next Oklahoma Legislature unless the joint  
23 resolution or bill specifies an earlier or later termination date.

1           2. Any advisory bodies created by bill or joint resolution  
2 prior to February 1, 1993, which creation or establishment is not  
3 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be terminated unless the  
4 advisory body is codified in the next decennial compilation of  
5 Oklahoma laws.

6           B. 1. Effective January 1, 1994, except as otherwise provided  
7 by this subsection, advisory bodies including, but not limited to,  
8 task forces, boards, commissions and councils created or established  
9 by simple resolutions or concurrent resolutions passed by the  
10 Legislature or either house thereof shall terminate the first day of  
11 the first regular session of the next Oklahoma Legislature, unless  
12 such simple or concurrent resolution specifies an earlier  
13 termination date.

14           2. Any such advisory body created prior to January 1, 1991, by  
15 a simple or concurrent resolution passed by the Legislature or  
16 either house thereof is hereby terminated.

17           C. If a task force or similar advisory body created pursuant to  
18 a codified section of law in a legislative measure on or after the  
19 effective date of this act does not conduct at least one meeting or  
20 issue its final report within three (3) years from the date upon  
21 which the section of law creating the task force or similar advisory  
22 body becomes effective, the task force or advisory body shall cease  
23 to have any authority to conduct any business and shall be  
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1 considered terminated by operation of law at the expiration of the  
2 three-year period.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.

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
