8 An Act relating to firearms; amending 19 O.S. 2001,
9 Section 215.29, which relates to the carrying of
10 firearms by district attorneys; authorizing assistant
11 district attorneys to carry firearms under certain
12 circumstances; providing for codification; and
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 215.29, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 215.29 A. A district attorney may carry a firearm on
18 his or her person anywhere in the state to use only for personal
19 protection if ~~he~~ the person has successfully completed an approved
20 course of firearm training conducted by a state certified firearms
21 instructor which meets the minimum requirements for firearms
22 training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education
23 and Training.

1 B. At the discretion of the district attorney, the district
2 attorney may allow an assistant district attorney to carry a firearm
3 on his or her person anywhere in the state to use only for personal
4 protection if the person has successfully completed an approved
5 course of firearm training conducted by a state certified firearms
6 instructor which meets the minimum requirements for firearms
7 training as set forth by the Council in Law Enforcement Education
8 and Training.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
