8 An Act relating to insurance; creating the Any
9 Willing Institute Task Force; stating purpose;
10 providing for membership of task force; authorizing
11 meetings; providing for reimbursement of certain
12 travel expenses; requiring quorum for certain
13 actions; specifying reporting requirements; providing
14 for codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-228.1 of Title 36, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. There is hereby created the "Any Willing Institute Task
20 Force".

21 B. The task force shall study the feasibility of establishing
22 an "Any Willing Institute" program, wherein any medical institution
23 may be compensated by insurers for services provided by the
24 institution regardless of whether the institute has a contractual

1 relationship with the insurer, provided that the institute agrees to
2 comply with the policy requirements of the insurer. The task force
3 shall study the following issues:

4 1. The cost to the state of an "Any Willing Institute Program";

5 2. Obstacles to statewide implementation of the program;

6 3. The development of a more integrated health care system to
7 facilitate cooperation between institutions as well as insurers;

8 4. The development of a comprehensive, state-wide "Any Willing
9 Institute" program; and

10 5. Any other issues necessary for creating an "Any Willing
11 Institute Program";

12 C. The task force shall be composed of eight (8) members as
13 follows:

14 1. The Oklahoma Insurance Commissioner or designee;

15 2. Three members appointed by the Governor;

16 3. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
17 Senate, one of whom shall be an administrator of a medical
18 institution; and

19 4. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of
20 Representatives, one of whom shall be a practicing physician;

21 D. The task force may meet as often as necessary to perform the
22 duties imposed upon it. Members of the task force shall receive no
23 compensation for their services, but shall receive travel
24 reimbursement as follows:

1 1. Legislative members of the task force shall be reimbursed
2 for necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their
3 duties in accordance with the provisions of Section 456 of Title 74
4 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5 2. Nonlegislative members of the task force shall be reimbursed
6 for necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their
7 duties in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

8 E. A quorum of the task force shall be required for any final
9 action, and shall report its findings and recommendations to the
10 President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
11 Representatives not later than May 1, 2012.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
