7 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending Section  
9 1, Chapter 124, O.S.L. 2007, as amended by Section 4,  
10 Chapter 98, O.S.L. 2008 (47 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section  
11 11-1117), which relates to all-terrain vehicle  
12 passenger restrictions; providing an exception to  
13 certain prohibited act; and providing an effective  
14 date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 124, O.S.L.  
17 2007, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 98, O.S.L. 2008 (47 O.S.  
18 Supp. 2009, Section 11-1117), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 11-1117. A. It shall be unlawful for a person less  
20 than eighteen (18) years of age to operate or to be carried as a  
21 passenger upon an all-terrain vehicle unless the person wears a  
22 crash helmet of a type which complies with standards established by  
23 49 C.F.R., Section 571.218.

24 B. It shall be unlawful for the operator of an all-terrain  
vehicle to carry a passenger unless that all-terrain vehicle has

1 | been specifically designed by the manufacturer to carry passengers  
2 | in addition to the operator or an aftermarket accessory has been  
3 | specifically manufactured and installed on the all-terrain vehicle  
4 | to allow for the carrying of passengers in addition to the operator.

5 | C. Fine and court costs for violating the provisions of this  
6 | section shall not exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). Any peace  
7 | officer of this state including, but not limited to, park rangers,  
8 | is authorized to enforce the provisions of this section. All monies  
9 | collected pursuant to a citation for a violation of this section  
10 | shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department  
11 | Revolving Fund for credit to the cost center of the state park or  
12 | public recreation area where such citation was issued.

13 | D. Any parent, legal guardian or person having actual  
14 | responsibility for a person under eighteen (18) years of age, or who  
15 | is the owner of the all-terrain vehicle operated by a person under  
16 | eighteen (18) years of age, who knows, or should have known, that  
17 | the person operating the all-terrain vehicle is not in compliance  
18 | with the provisions of this section, shall be punishable according  
19 | to the provisions of subsection C of this section.

20 | E. As used in this section, "all-terrain vehicle" means a  
21 | vehicle powered by an internal combustion engine manufactured and  
22 | used exclusively for off-highway use, traveling on four or more low-  
23 | pressure tires, having a seat designed to be straddled by the  
24 | operator, and which is steered by the use of handlebars.

1 F. The provisions of this section shall apply only to persons  
2 operating all-terrain vehicles on public lands.

3 G. The provisions of this section shall not apply to persons  
4 operating an all-terrain vehicle on privately owned property.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
