7 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State  
9 to refer to the people for their approval or  
10 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 6A of  
11 Article X of the Constitution of the State of  
12 Oklahoma; modifying internal reference; providing  
13 ballot title; and directing filing.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE  
15 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

16 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
17 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
18 the following proposed amendment to Section 6A of Article X of the  
19 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

20 Section 6A. Intangible personal property as ~~below~~ defined by  
21 this section shall not be subject to ad ~~valorem~~ valorem tax or to  
22 any other tax in lieu of ad valorem tax within this State:

23 (a) Money and cash on hand, including currency, gold, silver,  
24 and other coin, bank drafts, certified checks, and cashier's checks.

1 (b) Money on deposit in any bank, trust company, or other  
2 depository of money, within or without the State of Oklahoma,  
3 including certificates of deposit.

4 (c) Accounts and bills receivable, including brokerage  
5 accounts, and other credits, whether secured or unsecured.

6 (d) Bonds, promissory notes, debentures, and all other  
7 evidences of debt, whether secured or unsecured; except notes,  
8 debentures, and other evidences of debt secured by real estate  
9 mortgages which are subject to the Mortgage Registration Tax under  
10 Sections 12351 - 12362, inclusive, Oklahoma Statutes, 1931 (68  
11 O.S.1961, Sections 1171 - 1182).

12 (e) Shares of stock or other written evidence or proportional  
13 shares of beneficial interests in corporations, joint stock  
14 companies, associations, syndicates, express or business trusts,  
15 special or limited partnerships, or other business organizations.

16 (f) All interests in property held in trust or on deposit  
17 within or without this State, and whether or not evidenced by  
18 certificates, shares, or other written evidence of beneficial  
19 ownership.

20 (g) Final judgments for the payment of money.

21 (h) All annuities and annuity contracts.

22 The effective date of this Amendment shall be January 1, 1969;  
23 provided, that the intangible personal property taxes levied for the  
24 year 1968 shall be collected.

1 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
2 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
3 the following form:

7 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends  
8 Section 6A of Article 10. It changes an internal reference. It  
9 corrects a misspelling.
