16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
18 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

19 A. There is hereby created until November 30, 2009, a task
20 force to study smoking in public places. The task force shall:

21 1. Study current state laws in this state and other states
22 related to smoking in public places;

23 2. Study both the health effects associated with smoking and
24 the economic impact of smoking bans on local businesses; and

1 3. Provide recommendations on ways to improve state laws on
2 smoking in public places.

3 B. The task force shall be composed of twelve (12) members as
4 follows:

5 1. Four members appointed by the President Pro Tempore as
6 follows:

7 a. a representative of the State Department of Health,

8 b. a representative of a tobacco industry trade
9 association,

10 c. a representative of an association of advocates for
11 lung health in this state, and

12 d. a representative of an association of restaurants in
13 this state;

14 2. Four members appointed by the Speaker of the House of
15 Representatives as follows:

16 a. a representative of the Oklahoma Health Care
17 Authority,

18 b. a representative of the War Veterans Commission of
19 Oklahoma or the Oklahoma Veterans Council,

20 c. a representative of an association of advocates for
21 cancer prevention in this state, and

22 d. a representative of an association of bar owners in
23 this state;

1 3. The chairs of the Appropriations and Budget Health
2 Subcommittee and the Public Health Committee of the Oklahoma House
3 of Representatives; and

4 4. The chairs of the Health and Human Services Appropriations
5 Subcommittee and the Health and Human Services Committee of the
6 State Senate.

7 C. The members of the task force shall serve at the pleasure of
8 the appointing authority.

9 D. The chair and vice-chair of the task force shall be selected
10 by the task force from among the members.

11 E. A quorum of the task force shall be required in order for
12 any final action of the task force.

13 F. Nonlegislative members of the task force shall receive no
14 compensation for their service, but shall be reimbursed for
15 necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their
16 duties in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
17 Legislative members of the task force shall be reimbursed for
18 necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their
19 duties in accordance with the provisions of Section 456 of Title 74
20 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

21 G. Staff support for the task force shall be provided by the
22 State Department of Health.

23 H. The task force shall report its findings, including any
24 legislative recommendations, to the President Pro Tempore of the

1 Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the
2 Governor by November 30, 2009.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
