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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 453, O.S.L.
19 2009 (70 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 1210.453), is amended to read as
20 follows:

21 Section 1210.453 A. The board of trustees of the Oklahoma
22 School for the Visual and Performing Arts shall have the authority
23 to adopt rules necessary to comply with the provisions of ~~this act~~

1 Sections 1210.451 through 1210.453 of this title and any other
2 requirements placed upon the board of trustees by law.

3 B. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that the board
4 of trustees of the Oklahoma School for the Visual and Performing
5 Arts establish a hiring policy for the Oklahoma School for the
6 Visual and Performing Arts which provides that applicants for
7 employment positions with the school who are residents of this state
8 shall be given priority for employment over applicants who are not
9 residents of this state if all other qualifications are equal.

10 C. The Oklahoma School for the Visual and Performing Arts shall
11 not offer any campus summer arts camp programs for students in
12 grades nine through twelve during the period between the end of the
13 regular spring semester of the school and the beginning of the
14 regular fall semester of the school. For purposes of this section,
15 "campus summer arts camp programs" means programs in which students
16 are residentially housed as a group for two (2) weeks or less by the
17 school. The provisions of this subsection shall not be enforced if
18 either the Oklahoma Arts Institute, a nonprofit organization which
19 is funded in part by private and state funds and utilizes the Quartz
20 Mountain Arts and Conference Center and Nature Park for a fine arts
21 institute and continuing education programs, or the Oklahoma School
22 for the Visual and Performing Arts is not operating or ceases to
23 exist.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
