PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public retirement systems;
authorizing retirement benefit increases for certain
members of the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and
Retirement System, the Oklahoma Police Pension and
Retirement System, the Uniform Retirement System for
Justices and Judges, the Oklahoma Law Enforcement
Retirement System, the Teachers' Retirement System of
Oklahoma and the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement
System; specifying amount of benefit increase;
providing for codification; providing an effective
date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 49-143.7 of Title 11, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section and
except for persons receiving benefits pursuant to Section 49-101 of

1 Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes, effective July 1, 2010, any
2 person who is receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Firefighters
3 Pension and Retirement System as of June 30, 2009, who continues to
4 receive benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a
5 _____ increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

6 B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive
7 pursuant to repealed Section 49-136 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma
8 Statutes after June 30, 2008, shall be used to offset the increase
9 in benefits provided in subsection A of this section.

10 C. Effective July 1, 2010, any persons receiving benefits
11 pursuant to Section 49-101 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes
12 shall each receive a benefit equal to _____
13 for each year of credited service not to exceed thirty (30) years of
14 service.

15 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 50-136.9 of Title 11, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any
19 person who is receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Police Pension
20 and Retirement System as of June 30, 2009, who continues to receive
21 benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a _____
22 increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

23 B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive
24 pursuant to repealed Section 50-120 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma

1 Statutes after June 30, 2008, shall be offset by the increase in
2 benefits, if any, provided by this section.

3 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104K of Title 20, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 Any person who is receiving benefits from The Uniform Retirement
7 System for Justices and Judges as of June 30, 2009, who continues to
8 receive benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a
9 _____ increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

10 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-305.12 of Title 47, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any
14 person who is receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Law Enforcement
15 Retirement System as of June 30, 2009, who continues to receive
16 benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a _____
17 increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

18 B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive
19 pursuant to subsection B, C or D of Section 2-305 of Title 47 of the
20 Oklahoma Statutes, after June 30, 2010, shall be offset by the
21 increase in benefits, if any, provided by this section.

22 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 17-116.22 of Title 70, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. Any person who is receiving benefits from the Teachers'
2 Retirement System of Oklahoma as of June 30, 2009, other than those
3 benefits specified in subsection B of this section, who continues to
4 receive benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a
5 _____ increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

6 B. Any person receiving benefits pursuant to subsection (3) of
7 Section 17-105 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes whose benefits
8 commenced prior to July 1, 2009, and who continues to receive
9 benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a _____
10 increase in said benefits beginning in July 2010.

11 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 930.11 of Title 74, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 Any person who is receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Public
15 Employees Retirement System as of June 30, 2009, who continues to
16 receive benefits on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive a
17 _____ increase in said benefits beginning in July
18 2010.

19 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

20 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
