10 An Act relating to public buildings and public works;
11 amending 61 O.S. 2001, Section 103, as amended by
12 Section 15, Chapter 271, O.S.L. 2006 (61 O.S. Supp.
13 2009, Section 103), which relates to the Public
14 Competitive Bidding Act of 1974; providing
15 alternative process for satisfying competitive
16 bidding; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 61 O.S. 2001, Section 103, as
19 amended by Section 15, Chapter 271, O.S.L. 2006 (61 O.S. Supp. 2009,
20 Section 103), is amended to read as follows:

21 Section 103. A. Unless otherwise provided by law, all public
22 construction contracts exceeding Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00)
23 shall be let and awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, by open
24 competitive bidding after solicitation for sealed bids, in
accordance with the provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act

1 of 1974. No work shall be commenced until a written contract is
2 executed and all required bonds and insurance have been provided by
3 the contractor to the awarding public agency.

4 B. Except as provided in subsection D of this section, public
5 construction contracts less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00)
6 shall be let and awarded to the lowest responsible bidder by receipt
7 of written bids. No work shall be commenced until a written
8 contract is executed and proof of insurance has been provided by the
9 contractor to the awarding public agency.

10 C. Except as provided in subsection D of this section, public
11 construction contracts for less than Two Thousand Five Hundred
12 Dollars (\$2,500.00) for minor maintenance or minor repair work may
13 be negotiated with a qualified contractor. No work shall be
14 commenced until a written contract is executed and proof of
15 insurance has been provided by the contractor to the awarding public
16 agency.

17 D. The provisions of this subsection shall apply to public
18 construction for minor maintenance or minor repair work to public
19 school district property. Such public construction contracts for
20 less than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) may be
21 negotiated with a qualified contractor. Such public construction
22 contracts equal to or greater than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars
23 (\$25,000.00) but less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall
24 be let and awarded to the lowest responsible bidder by receipt of

1 written bids. No work shall be commenced on any such public
2 construction contract until a written contract is executed and proof
3 of insurance has been provided by the contractor to the awarding
4 public agency.

5 E. Requirements for competitive bidding shall be satisfied by
6 both public school districts and technology center school districts
7 through their participation in the bidding process of an interlocal
8 joint or cooperative undertaking formed pursuant to Section 1004 of
9 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
