9 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to gaming; creating the Task Force
11 for the Study of Lottery and Gaming Revenues;
12 providing for membership of Task Force; requiring
13 organizational meeting; providing for quorum;
14 requiring study of certain lottery and gaming issues;
15 defining scope of study; providing Task Force subject
16 to certain statutory provisions; providing for staff
17 assistance; requiring final report; providing for
18 termination of Task Force; providing for
19 codification; and declaring an emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 100 of Title 3A, unless there is
23 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 A. There is hereby created the Task Force for the Study of
Lottery and Gaming Revenues.

1 B. The Task Force shall consist of nine (9) members to be
2 appointed or selected as follows:

3 1. Three members to be appointed by the Governor at least one
4 of whom shall be a principal member of the Governor's staff;

5 2. Three members, who shall be members of the Oklahoma House of
6 Representatives, to be appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma
7 House of Representatives; and

8 3. Three members, who shall be members of the Oklahoma State
9 Senate, to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the State
10 Senate.

11 C. The Task Force shall conduct an organizational meeting not
12 later than September 1, 2010. A majority of the members present at
13 the organizational meeting or any subsequent meeting shall
14 constitute a quorum for the purpose of any action taken including
15 the preparation and approval of the final report required by
16 subsection H of this section.

17 D. The Task Force shall be authorized to meet as necessary in
18 order to perform the duties imposed upon it. Legislative members of
19 the Task Force shall be reimbursed for travel expenses pursuant to
20 the provisions of Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
21 Other members of the Task Force shall be reimbursed as provided by
22 the appointing authority.

23 E. The Task Force shall conduct a study reviewing and
24 evaluating lottery and gaming policies in the state and examining

1 lottery and gaming revenues accruing to the state and their impact
2 on the state budget.

3 F. The Task Force shall be subject to the provisions of:

4 1. The Oklahoma Open Meeting Act; and

5 2. The Oklahoma Open Records Act.

6 G. Staff assistance for the Task Force shall be provided by the
7 staff of the Oklahoma House of Representative and the State Senate.

8 H. The Task Force shall produce a final written report of its
9 findings and any recommendations regarding state law with respect to
10 lottery and gaming. The report shall be submitted to the Governor,
11 the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the
12 President Pro Tempore of the State Senate not later than December
13 31, 2010.

14 I. The provisions of this section shall cease to have the force
15 and effect of law and the Task Force shall terminate effective
16 January 1, 2011.

17 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
