11 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
12 2001, Section 6-110.2, as last amended by Section 6,
13 Chapter 159, O.S.L. 2008 (47 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section
14 6-110.2), which relates to computerized finger
15 imaging; authorizing override of finger image in
16 certain circumstances; requiring means for certain
17 purpose; and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 6-110.2, as
20 last amended by Section 6, Chapter 159, O.S.L. 2008 (47 O.S. Supp.
21 2009, Section 6-110.2), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 6-110.2 A. The Department of Public Safety shall
23 implement a procedure for computerized finger imaging by means of an
24 inkless finger image scanning device and shall require every
applicant for an original, renewal or replacement driver license or

1 identification card to submit to finger imaging for the purposes of
2 proof of identity and to ensure the security of the driver license
3 or identification card issued to the applicant. If the finger image
4 of a person over sixty-five (65) cannot be scanned and the issuing
5 agent can personally verify the individual's identity with
6 alternative identification the finger imaging shall be overridden.
7 Means must be provided to trace to the agent who authorized the
8 override.

9 B. No unemancipated person under eighteen (18) years of age
10 shall be issued a driver license or identification card by the
11 Department unless an authorization form, prescribed and furnished by
12 the Department, authorizing the finger imaging of the person and
13 signed by the legal custodial parent, legal guardian, or legal
14 custodian of the person, is in the possession of the Department.

15 C. No law enforcement agency of the state or federal government
16 other than the Department of Public Safety shall have access to any
17 information collected through the use of computerized finger imaging
18 without first obtaining a court order from a judge of competent
19 jurisdiction. Each application for an order authorizing the access
20 to any information collected through the use of computerized finger
21 imaging shall be made in writing upon oath or affirmation to a judge
22 of competent jurisdiction. Each application shall establish
23 probable cause for belief that a named individual is committing, has
24 committed or is about to commit a particular violation of law.

1 D. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall adopt rules as may
2 be necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective February 1, 2011.
