11 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;  
12 designating the Master Sergeant Houston K. Blackburn  
13 Memorial Highway; designating the PFC Lonnie D. Loyd,  
14 Jr. Memorial Highway; designating the George Freas  
15 Memorial Bridge; designating the Fallen Heroes  
16 Memorial Bridge; designating the 95th Division  
17 Memorial Highway; designating the E. A. Woods  
18 Memorial Highway; designating the Representative Opio  
19 Toure Memorial Highway; designating the USMC Cpl.  
20 Jeremy D. Allbaugh Memorial Highway; designating the  
21 James W. Summerlin Memorial Highway; providing for  
22 placement of permanent markers; providing for  
23 codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.60 of Title 69, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1        That portion of State Highway 7 from the Atoka city limits  
2 extending west to the Johnston County line shall be designated as  
3 the "Master Sergeant Houston K. Blackburn Memorial Highway". The  
4 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
5 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

6        SECTION 2.        NEW LAW        A new section of law to be codified  
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.61 of Title 69, unless  
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9        That portion of State Highway 48 from the junction of State  
10 Highway 48 and State Highway 7 extending north to the Johnston  
11 County line shall be designated as the "PFC Lonnie D. Loyd, Jr.  
12 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
13 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that  
14 name.

15        SECTION 3.        NEW LAW        A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.62 of Title 69, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18        The bridge on State Highway 31 approximately four (4) miles  
19 southwest of Ashland in Coal County shall be designated the "George  
20 Freas Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall  
21 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing  
22 that name.

1 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.63 of Title 69, unless  
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge crossing Bull Creek on East State Highway 60  
5 approximately one (1) mile east of the junction of East State  
6 Highway 60 and State Highway 2 in Craig County shall be designated  
7 the "Fallen Heroes Memorial Bridge". The Department of  
8 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed  
9 on the bridge bearing that name.

10 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.64 of Title 69, unless  
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 That portion of Interstate 44 located in Comanche County from  
14 the junction of Interstate 44 and State Highway 7 extending north to  
15 mile marker 46 shall be designated as the "95th Division Memorial  
16 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
17 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

18 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.65 of Title 69, unless  
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The portion of State Highway 46 from the junction of State  
22 Highway 46 and State Highway 15 extending south to the junction of  
23 State Highway 46 and the Sharon-Shattuck Road shall be designated as  
24 the "E.A. Woods Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation

1 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway  
2 bearing that name.

3 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.66 of Title 69, unless  
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The portion of Interstate 35 in Oklahoma City between Northeast  
7 23rd Street and Interstate 40 shall be designated as the  
8 "Representative Opio Toure Memorial Highway". The Department of  
9 Transportation shall place suitable permanent markers on the highway  
10 bearing that name.

11 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.67 of Title 69, unless  
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of State Highway 11 in Blackwell between Interstate  
15 35 and 13th Street shall be designated as the "USMC Cpl. Jeremy D.  
16 Allbaugh Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall  
17 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing  
18 that name.

19 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.68 of Title 69, unless  
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The portion of State Highway 88 between Inola and Claremore  
23 shall be designated the "James W. Summerlin Memorial Highway". The  
24

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
2 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
