8 An Act relating to crimes and punishment; creating
9 offense for distribution of certain images;
10 specifying conduct for violation; establishing
11 penalty for violation; providing for codification;
12 and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 650.12 of Title 21, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 It shall be unlawful for any person to upload video or digital
18 images to any website that is accessible by the public via the
19 Internet when the video or digital images are recorded by any
20 electronic device capable of recording such material and the
21 material recorded contains a prosecutable offense of assault and
22 battery involving at least one minor. To constitute a violation of
23 this section, the person or persons conducting the recording shall
24

1 have prior knowledge that a potential assault and battery was about
2 to occur.

3 A person in violation of this section, upon conviction, shall be
4 guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine up to Seven Hundred
5 Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) for each offense.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
