HB2971

By: Sanders of the House and Marlatt of the Senate

Title: Emergency and Transportation Revolving Fund; relating to the apportionment of monies to the General Revenue Fund; crediting investment interest to the Statewide Circuit Engineering District Revolving Fund. Effective date.

Together with Engrossed Senate Amendments thereto, beg leave to report that we have had the same under consideration and herewith return the same with the following recommendations:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
2. That the following Conference Committee Amendments be adopted:
 - a. Page 4, line 16 by deleting Section 3.
 - b. Page 4, line 16 by adding a new Section 3 to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

And amending the title to conform.


