

in businesses transporting minors consuming alcohol Effective date.



together with Engrossed House Amendments thereto, beg leave to report that we have had the
same under consideration and herewith return the same with the following recommendations:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment.
2. By restoring the enacting clause.
3. By restoring the title to read as follows:
"An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; prohibiting possession or consumption of alcohol
by minors in certain commercial vehicles; stating violations; stating punishments;
providing for revocation of certain licenses and permits; requiring report of violations to
the Corporation Commission; authorizing reinstatement following certain time period,
authorizing agencies to promulgate rules to implement act; amending 47 O.S. 2001,
Section 6-205, as last amended by Section 17, Chapter 311, O.S.L. 2006 (47 O.S. Supp.
2009, Section 6-205), which relates to mandatory revocation of driving privileges;
providing penalty for certain offense; providing for codification; and providing an effective
date."
