11 An Act relating to public health and safety; defining
12 terms; making certain acts unlawful; exempting
13 certain acts; stating punishment; providing for
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-727 of Title 63, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. As used in this section, the term:

21 1. "Human cloning" means human asexual reproduction,
22 accomplished by introducing the nuclear material of a human somatic
23 cell into a fertilized or unfertilized oocyte whose nucleus has been

1 removed or inactivated to produce a living organism (at any stage of
2 development) with a human genetic constitution;

3 2. "Somatic cell" means a diploid cell (having a complete set
4 of chromosomes) obtained or derived from a living or deceased human
5 body at any stage of development;

6 3. "Nucleus" means the cell structure that houses the
7 chromosomes, and thus the genes; and

8 4. "Oocyte" means the female germ cell, the egg.

9 B. It shall be unlawful for any person or entity, public or
10 private, to:

11 1. Perform or attempt to perform human cloning;

12 2. Participate in an attempt to perform human cloning;

13 3. Ship, transfer, or receive the product of human cloning for
14 any purpose; or

15 4. Import the product of human cloning for any purpose.

16 C. Nothing in this section shall restrict areas of scientific
17 research not specifically prohibited by this section, including
18 research in the use of nuclear transfer or other cloning techniques
19 to produce molecules, DNA, cells other than human embryos, tissues,
20 organs, plants, or animals other than humans.

21 D. Any person or entity that is convicted of violating any
22 provision of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
