11 An Act relating to state government personnel;
12 amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 840-5.10, as last
13 amended by Section 1, Chapter 316, O.S.L. 2006 (74
14 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 840-5.10), which relates to
15 unclassified service and personnel; adding certain
16 positions from CompSource Oklahoma; providing an
17 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 840-5.10, as
20 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 316, O.S.L. 2006 (74 O.S. Supp.
21 2008, Section 840-5.10), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 840-5.10 A. CompSource Oklahoma shall be under the
23 Merit System. Except as otherwise provided in subsection B of this
24 section, all offices, positions and personnel shall be classified

1 and subject to the provisions of the Merit System of Personnel
2 Administration and rules promulgated hereunder. This section shall
3 supersede and repeal any and all executive orders issued pursuant to
4 this act to place the agency or its predecessors under the Merit
5 System.

6 B. In addition to offices, positions and personnel that are
7 unclassified pursuant to Section 840-5.5 of this title, the
8 following offices, positions and personnel shall be in the
9 unclassified service:

- 10 1. President and Chief Executive Officer;
- 11 2. Executive Vice President;
- 12 3. Vice Presidents;
- 13 4. Executive Secretaries to the President, Executive Vice
14 President and Vice Presidents;
- 15 5. Law Clerks and Legal Assistants;
- 16 6. Special Counsel;
- 17 7. General Counsel;
- 18 8. Medical Analysts Supervisor;
- 19 9. Medical Analysts;
- 20 10. Field Adjusters;
- 21 11. Investment Officer;
- 22 12. Workers' Compensation Insurance Consultants;
- 23 13. Workers' Compensation Insurance Technicians;
- 24 14. Workers' Compensation Insurance Adjusters;

- 1 15. Workers' Compensation Insurance Underwriters;
- 2 16. Information Systems Personnel;
- 3 17. Fraud Investigation Specialists; ~~and~~
- 4 18. Collections Attorneys;
- 5 19. Premium Auditors; and
- 6 20. Safety Consultants.

7 C. CompSource Oklahoma may develop a plan for a program for
8 incentive-based compensation for its employees. The plan shall be
9 subject to the review and approval of the Insurance Commissioner.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
