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10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the State Board of Education;
12 amending Section 1, Chapter 421, O.S.L. 2009, as
13 amended by Section 1, Chapter 449, O.S.L. 2009,
14 Section 3, Chapter 449, O.S.L. 2009 and Section 3,
15 Chapter 421, O.S.L. 2009, which relate to
16 appropriations and expenditure authorizations;
17 modifying appropriation amount; modifying expenditure
18 authorizations; making appropriations; stating
19 purposes; making appropriations exempt from fiscal
20 year limitations; and declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 421, O.S.L.
23 2009, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 449, O.S.L. 2009, is amended
24 to read as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year

1 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of ~~One Billion One Hundred Eighty-one~~
2 ~~Million One Hundred Ninety-four Thousand Four Hundred Dollars~~
3 ~~(\$1,181,194,400.00)~~ One Billion One Hundred Thirteen Million Three
4 Hundred Eighty-six Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-seven Dollars
5 (\$1,113,386,837.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the
6 financial support of public schools.

7 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 449, O.S.L.
8 2009, is amended to read as follows:

9 Section 3. The State Board of Education is hereby authorized to
10 expend from the Education Stabilization component of the American
11 Recovery and Reinvestment Act Fund ("490 Fund"), the sum of ~~One~~
12 ~~Hundred Sixty-seven Million Five Hundred Fifty-nine Thousand Six~~
13 ~~Hundred Fifty-one Dollars (\$167,559,651.00)~~ Two Hundred Four Million
14 Seven Hundred Eleven Thousand Six Hundred Sixteen Dollars
15 (\$204,711,616.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
16 the duties imposed upon the State Board of Education by law.

17 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 421, O.S.L.
18 2009, is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 3. The State Board of Education is hereby authorized to
20 expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, from the Common
21 Education Technology Revolving Fund of the State Treasury, the sum
22 of ~~Thirty-three Million One Hundred Ninety-six Thousand Eight~~
23 ~~Hundred Ninety-three Dollars (\$33,196,893.00)~~ Forty-seven Million
24 Three Hundred Seventy-two Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-nine Dollars

1 (\$47,372,299.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the
2 financial support of public schools.

3 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
4 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
5 Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Fifteen Million
6 Six Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars
7 (\$15,655,598.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for
8 financial support of public schools.

9 SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
10 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
11 Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Fifty
12 Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
13 necessary to replace the shortfall in revenue authorized to be
14 expended from the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section
15 34.89 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

16 SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
17 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
18 Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Forty
19 Million Two Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-four
20 Dollars (\$40,264,594.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for
21 financial support of public schools.

22 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by Sections 4 through 6 of this
23 act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be
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1 available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of
2 thirty (30) months from the effective date of this act.

3 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
