8 An Act relating to Oklahoma historical societies; authorizing the Oklahoma
9 Historical Society with the duty of marking the gravesites of deceased
10 Oklahoma Governors; requiring gravesite markers to readily identify the
11 gravesite; authorizing the Oklahoma Historical Society to hold property;
12 granting the Oklahoma Historical Society certain authority; providing for
13 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as
16 Section 6.1 of Title 53, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Oklahoma Historical Society is given the authority to mark the gravesites of deceased
18 Governors of the State of Oklahoma which are located in Oklahoma with historical markers that
19 readily identify the gravesite.

20 B. The Oklahoma Historical Society may purchase and hold property as may be necessary to
21 erect the historical gravesite markers.

22 C. The Oklahoma Historical Society shall have authority to:

- 23 1. Designate the approximate location of the historical gravesite markers;
24 2. Preserve the historical gravesite markers;

- 3. Design the historical gravesite markers;
- 4. Accept gifts and donations for the erection and preservation of the gravesite markers; and
- 5. Encourage local participation in and contribution to the erection and preservation of the gravesite markers through the use of gifts, donations, and matching-fund agreements.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
