8 An Act relating to state government; providing for  
9 certain bidding preference related to contracts  
10 subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Central  
11 Purchasing Act; providing preference based upon  
12 employer-provided health care; providing for  
13 codification; providing an effective date; and  
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.17A-1 of Title 74, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 When multiple bids for a contract which is subject to the  
20 provisions of the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act are otherwise  
21 equal in quality and price, the Department of Central Services shall  
22 ascertain if one or more of the bidders provide health care  
23 insurance to their employees and shall provide a selection  
24 preference in favor of bidders who are willing to provide employee

1 health care insurance during the term in which the contract shall be  
2 in force and effect.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
