8 An Act relating to soldiers and sailors; amending
9 Section 1, Chapter 363, O.S.L. 2008 (72 O.S. Supp.
10 2008, Section 7), which relates to certain veteran
11 benefits; providing certain benefits to Oklahoma
12 active-duty service members; providing certain
13 benefits to Oklahoma National Guard and Reserve
14 service members; providing certain identification
15 requirements; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 363, O.S.L.
18 2008 (72 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 7), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 7. A. All honorably discharged veterans who are
20 currently Oklahoma residents shall be allowed free admission to all
21 state-owned or state-operated parks and museums. A valid Oklahoma
22 driver license or state photo identification card and military
23 discharge papers (DD Form 214) or similar evidence of an honorable
24 discharge from the United States Armed Forces shall be required for
free admission.

1 B. All active-duty members of the United States Armed Forces
2 and all active members of any Oklahoma National Guard or Reserve
3 component who are currently Oklahoma residents shall be allowed free
4 admission to all state-owned or state-operated parks and museums. A
5 valid Oklahoma driver license or state photo identification and
6 valid military identification card shall be required for free
7 admission.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
