10 An Act relating to torts; providing immunity from  
11 liability for person making certain report; stating  
12 exception; providing for codification; and providing  
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7.1 of Title 76, unless there is  
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Any person who, in good faith and exercising due care, makes a  
19 report of alleged terrorist activity of another person or persons to  
20 a federal, state or local law enforcement officer or agency or other  
21 security personnel shall have immunity from any civil or criminal  
22 liability that might otherwise be incurred or imposed. This section  
23 shall not apply to any person who willfully or recklessly makes a

1 false report to a federal, state or local law enforcement officer or  
2 agency or other security personnel.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
