10 SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

11 An Act relating to schools; amending 63 O.S. 2001,
12 Section 2152, which relates to the donation of blood;
13 permitting a person sixteen years of age to donate
14 blood under certain circumstance; and providing an
15 effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 2152, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 2152. Any person sixteen (16) years of age with
21 parental permission or authorization, or seventeen (17) years of age
22 or older without parental permission or authorization shall be
23 eligible to donate blood voluntarily ~~without the necessity of~~
24 ~~obtaining parental permission or authorization~~; provided that only

1 persons eighteen (18) years of age or older may receive compensation
2 for blood so donated.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
