9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to motor license agents; requiring  
11 motor license agents be included in certain online  
12 systems; providing for certain fees; setting deadline  
13 for installation and operation; providing for  
14 codification; providing an effective date; and  
15 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1132A of Title 47, unless there  
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. In any online system administered by the Oklahoma Tax  
21 Commission dealing with the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
22 Registration Act the Tax Commission shall include a step where the  
23 individual must select between any motor license agent in the state

1 and the Tax Commission to process any registration renewal or other  
2 request.

3 B. Motor license agents shall receive all fees provided by  
4 statute for registration renewals or other requests processed by the  
5 motor license agent through any online system administered by the  
6 Tax Commission.

7 C. The selection step required pursuant to subsection A of this  
8 section shall be installed and operational no later than July 1,  
9 2010.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
