16 ~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-106a of Title 47, unless there  
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 No person shall be allowed to obtain or renew a driver license  
21 or identification card pursuant to Sections 6-106 and 6-115 of Title  
22 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if there exists an outstanding warrant  
23 for the person from an Oklahoma state or municipal court and the

1 warrant has been reported to the Department of Public Safety  
2 pursuant to Section 1143.2 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1112a of Title 47, unless there  
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 No person shall be allowed to obtain or renew a motor vehicle  
7 registration pursuant to the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
8 Registration Act if there exists an outstanding warrant for the  
9 person from an Oklahoma state or municipal court and the warrant has  
10 been reported to the Department of Public Safety pursuant to Section  
11 1143.2 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
