15 ~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 61 O.S. 2001, Section 103, as  
17 amended by Section 15, Chapter 271, O.S.L. 2006 (61 O.S. Supp. 2009,  
18 Section 103), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 103. A. Unless otherwise provided by law, all public  
20 construction contracts exceeding Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00)  
21 shall be let and awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, by open  
22 competitive bidding after solicitation for sealed bids, in  
23 accordance with the provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act  
24 of 1974. No work shall be commenced until a written contract is

1 executed and all required bonds and insurance have been provided by  
2 the contractor to the awarding public agency.

3 B. Except as provided in subsection D of this section, public  
4 construction contracts less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00)  
5 shall be let and awarded to the lowest responsible bidder by receipt  
6 of written bids. No work shall be commenced until a written  
7 contract is executed and proof of insurance has been provided by the  
8 contractor to the awarding public agency.

9 C. Except as provided in subsection D of this section, public  
10 construction contracts for less than Two Thousand Five Hundred  
11 Dollars (\$2,500.00) for minor maintenance or minor repair work may  
12 be negotiated with a qualified contractor. No work shall be  
13 commenced until a written contract is executed and proof of  
14 insurance has been provided by the contractor to the awarding public  
15 agency.

16 D. The provisions of this subsection shall apply to public  
17 construction for minor maintenance or minor repair work to public  
18 school district property. Such public construction contracts for  
19 less than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) may be  
20 negotiated with a qualified contractor. Such public construction  
21 contracts equal to or greater than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars  
22 (\$25,000.00) but less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall  
23 be let and awarded to the lowest responsible bidder by receipt of  
24 written bids. No work shall be commenced on any such public

1 construction contract until a written contract is executed and proof  
2 of insurance has been provided by the contractor to the awarding  
3 public agency.

4 E. Requirements for competitive bidding shall be satisfied by  
5 both public school districts and technology center school districts  
6 through their participation in the bidding process of an interlocal  
7 joint or cooperative undertaking formed pursuant to Section 1004 of  
8 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
