10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the District Attorneys Council;  
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
15 providing budgetary limitations; authorizing the  
16 District Attorneys Council to hire certain number of  
17 legal interns for certain period of time; exempting  
18 interns from budgetary limitations; providing lapse  
19 dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budget  
20 practices; providing an effective date; and declaring  
21 an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
24 District Attorneys Council shall budget all funds in the following  
categories and amounts:

10 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
11 each budget category.

12 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
14 upon the district attorneys and District Attorneys Council by law  
15 shall be set by the District Attorneys Council except as otherwise  
16 provided in Chapter 7A of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The  
17 District Attorneys Council for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,  
18 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-  
19 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures  
20 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized  
21 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the  
22 Oklahoma Statutes:

1 Lease-Purchase Agreements \$0.00

2 SECTION 3. The District Attorneys Council is hereby authorized  
3 to hire twenty (20) legal interns for the fiscal year ending June  
4 30, 2010. Such interns shall be exempt from the budgetary  
5 limitations as provided in Section 2 of this act.

6 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by Section 116 of Enrolled  
7 Senate Bill No. 216 of the 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma  
8 Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay  
9 purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010  
10 (hereafter FY-10), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending  
11 June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11). Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be  
12 encumbered only through June 30, 2010, and must be expended by  
13 November 15, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, and  
14 not budgeted for FY-11, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund  
15 for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be  
16 encumbered only through June 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after  
17 November 15, 2011, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for  
18 the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be  
19 budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-  
20 10, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be  
21 budgeted for FY-11, after the agency to which the funds have been  
22 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program  
23 revision removing these funds from the FY-10 budget work program and

1 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State  
2 Finance.

3 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

4 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
