11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 401 of Title 25, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 English shall be designated as the common language of Oklahoma.
16 Except as otherwise provided by federal or state law, no agency or
17 political subdivision of this state shall be required, and no person
18 shall have a cause of action against an agency or political
19 subdivision of this state for failure to provide any documents,
20 information, literature or other written materials in any language
21 other than English.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
