9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to wildlife; amending 29 O.S. 2001,
11 Section 4-114, as last amended by Section 16, Chapter
12 16, O.S.L. 2006 (29 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 4-114),
13 which relates to hunting and fishing license;
14 authorizing persons under a certain age to purchase
15 certain licenses during a certain period of time;
16 providing for forfeiture under certain circumstances;
17 and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 4-114, as
20 last amended by Section 16, Chapter 16, O.S.L. 2006 (29 O.S. Supp.
21 2009, Section 4-114), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 4-114. A. All legal residents who have resided in the
23 state for at least six (6) months may purchase lifetime fishing
24 licenses, lifetime hunting licenses or lifetime combination

1 hunting/fishing licenses from the State Wildlife Conservation
2 Director.

3 B. 1. The fee for these licenses shall be:

4 ~~1. Lifetime~~

5 a. lifetime fishing license, Two Hundred Dollars
6 (\$200.00) †

7 ~~2. Lifetime~~

8 b. lifetime hunting license, Six Hundred Dollars
9 (\$600.00) †

10 ~~3. Lifetime~~

11 c. lifetime combination hunting/fishing license, Seven
12 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) †

13 ~~4. Lifetime~~

14 d. lifetime hunting license for persons sixty (60) years
15 of age or older, Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) †

16 ~~5. Lifetime~~

17 e. lifetime fishing license for persons sixty (60) years
18 of age or older, Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) † and

19 ~~6. Lifetime~~

20 f. lifetime combination hunting/fishing license for
21 persons sixty (60) years of age or older, Two Hundred
22 Fifteen Dollars (\$215.00).

23 2. The fee for a resident lifetime fishing license, a lifetime
24 hunting license, or a lifetime combination hunting/fishing license

1 for a legal resident of Oklahoma under eighteen (18) years of age
2 may be paid for by installments not to exceed a three-year-period of
3 time and in a manner determined by the Director. The lifetime
4 license will only be issued and become valid upon full payment. If
5 the entire license fee is not received three (3) years from the date
6 the application is received, any funds received shall be forfeited
7 and will not be refunded.

8 C. Legal resident having proper certification from the United
9 States Department of Veterans Affairs or its successor certifying
10 that the person is a disabled veteran may purchase a disability
11 lifetime combination hunting/fishing license from the State Wildlife
12 Conservation Director. The fees for the license shall be as
13 follows:

14 1. Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for veterans having a
15 disability of less than sixty percent (60%); and

16 2. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for veterans having a
17 disability of sixty percent (60%) or more.

18 D. The use of the licenses provided in this section are subject
19 to those restrictions provided by statute and the regulations of the
20 Wildlife Conservation Commission. Except as otherwise provided for
21 in this section, the lifetime hunting license shall be in lieu of
22 all annual hunting licenses and all special season permits.

1 E. Nonresidents may purchase a lifetime nonresident fishing
2 license. The fee for such license shall be Two Hundred Fifty
3 Dollars (\$250.00).

4 F. Should any lifetime license be lost or destroyed, a
5 duplicate will be issued by the Department of Wildlife Conservation
6 for a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

7 G. A lifetime licensee shall not lose the privileges of such
8 license by a subsequent transfer of residency.

9 H. 1. In addition to the fees imposed pursuant to subsections
10 B, C and E of this section, a person purchasing a lifetime fishing,
11 hunting or combination license shall be required to purchase a
12 Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp. ~~Each person shall have the~~
13 ~~stamp in their possession while hunting, fishing, or taking any~~
14 ~~wildlife.~~ The fee for the Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp
15 shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) which will be added to the
16 respective lifetime license fee. The fee for the stamp shall be
17 distributed as follows:

18 a. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) from each stamp shall be
19 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created
20 in Section 4-141 of this title, to be used to retire
21 the obligations and related expenses as authorized
22 pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma
23 Statutes or to purchase, lease, or purchase easements
24

1 on real property to be used as public hunting,
2 fishing, and trapping areas; and

3 b. Five Dollars (\$5.00) from each stamp shall be
4 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created
5 in Section 4-141 of this title, to be used by the
6 Commission for management of the real property
7 acquired pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the
8 Oklahoma Statutes or acquired with proceeds from the
9 Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee.

10 2. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall
11 prescribe, by rule, the form, design, and manner of issuance of the
12 Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp.

13 3. Within one (1) year of the final retirement, redemption, or
14 defeasance of the obligations created pursuant to Section 168.9 of
15 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife
16 Land Stamp and Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee
17 requirements provided for in this subsection shall terminate.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2011.
