12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5086.11 of Title 74, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. The Oklahoma Legislature recognizes the need to attract
17 highly-skilled workers and bring talented former Oklahomans back to
18 the state to connect with Oklahoma employers and career
19 opportunities.

20 B. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall maintain a website
21 dedicated to the Department's Boomerang program. The website shall
22 include first-person testimonials, career information, job openings,
23 housing data, social and recreational opportunities and any other

1 information deemed appropriate by the Department to support the
2 functions of the Boomerang program.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
