7 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to schools; creating the Task Force  
9 on the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities  
10 Association; stating duties; providing for  
11 membership, appointment, designation of officers,  
12 quorum, and staff support; prohibiting payment of  
13 travel expenses; requiring report of findings and  
14 recommendations; providing for noncodification; and  
15 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
18 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

19 A. There is hereby created until November 30, 2010, the Task  
20 Force on the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association for  
21 the purpose of improving oversight and accountability of the  
22 coordination and regulation of secondary school interscholastic  
23 activities, including the expenditure of tax dollars to support such  
24 activities.

1 B. The task force shall consist of seven (7) members as  
2 follows:

3 1. Two members of the Senate, appointed by the President Pro  
4 Tempore of the Senate;

5 2. Two members of the House of Representatives, appointed by  
6 the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

7 3. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction, or designee;

8 4. One member, selected from among public school  
9 superintendents, appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the  
10 Senate; and

11 5. One member, selected from among public school district board  
12 members, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

13 C. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall designate the  
14 chair of the task force. The Speaker of the House of  
15 Representatives shall designate the vice-chair of the task force.  
16 Appointments to the task force shall be made within thirty (30) days  
17 of enactment of this legislation. Meetings of the task force shall  
18 be held at the call of the chair of the task force. Members shall  
19 serve at the pleasure of their appointing authorities. A majority  
20 of the members of the task force shall constitute a quorum to  
21 transact business, but no vacancy shall impair the right of the  
22 remaining members to exercise all of the powers of the task force.  
23 A vacancy on the task force shall be filled by the original  
24 appointing authority. Staff support for the task force shall be

1 provided by the Senate, the House of Representatives, and the State  
2 Department of Education. Members shall not be reimbursed for travel  
3 expenses related to their duties on the task force.

4 D. The task force shall submit a report of findings and  
5 recommendations to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the  
6 Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

7 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
