15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 504, O.S.L.
17 2004, as last amended by Section 31, Chapter 1, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S.
18 Supp. 2008, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
20 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
21 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
22 provided by this section.

23 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
24 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of

1 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
2 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
3 registered for the current year.

4 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
5 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
6 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
7 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
8 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
9 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
10 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
11 amateur radio operator license plates.

12 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
13 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
14 applications for special license plates authorized under this
15 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
16 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
17 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
18 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
19 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
20 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
21 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
22 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
2 follows:

3 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
5 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
6 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
7 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
8 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
9 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
10 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
11 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
12 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
13 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
14 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
15 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
16 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
17 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

18 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
20 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
21 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
22 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

23 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National

1 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
2 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
3 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

4 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
5 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States
6 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
7 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
8 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
9 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
10 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying
11 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
12 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or
13 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
14 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
15 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
16 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

17 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
18 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
19 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
20 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
21 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
22 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

23 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are

1 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
2 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
3 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
4 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
5 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
6 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
7 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
8 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
9 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
10 of one (1) ton or less;

11 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
13 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
14 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
15 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
16 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
17 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
18 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
19 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
20 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
21 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
22 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the

1 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
2 the United States as being:

- 3 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
4 7, 1941,
- 5 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
6 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
7 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
8 exceed three (3) miles, and
- 9 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
10 States Armed Forces.

11 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
12 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
13 less;

14 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
15 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
16 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
17 States as being:

- 18 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
19 of 1945,
- 20 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
21 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 22 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
23 States Armed Forces.

24

1 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
2 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
4 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
5 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
6 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
7 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
8 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
9 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
10 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
11 registration after the initial issue;

12 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
14 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
15 the United States as being:

- 16 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
17 1944,
- 18 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
19 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
20 participation cannot be verified by the United States
21 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
22 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
23 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
24 the person applying for the license plate, and

1 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
2 States Armed Forces.

3 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
4 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

5 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
7 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
8 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
9 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
10 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
11 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
12 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
13 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
14 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
15 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
16 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
17 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
18 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

19 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
21 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
22 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
23 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
24 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent

1 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
2 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
3 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
4 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
5 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
6 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

7 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
9 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
10 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
11 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
12 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
13 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

14 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
16 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
17 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
18 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
21 police officer or full-time or reserve university police officer
22 certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
23 or common education police officer certified by the Council on Law
24 Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may apply for

1 police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of
2 one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of employment by
3 or retirement from a municipal or university police department by
4 either an identification card or letter from the chief of the police
5 department or the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement Board.
6 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
7 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
8 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
9 designed in consultation with municipal police departments of this
10 state; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar
11 design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new
12 design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license
13 plate;

14 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
16 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
17 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
18 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
19 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
20 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
21 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
22 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

23 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
24 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia

1 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
2 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
3 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
4 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
5 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
6 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
7 bottom of the license plate shall be the words "WORLD WAR II";

8 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
10 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
11 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
12 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
13 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
14 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
15 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
16 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

17 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
18 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
19 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
20 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
21 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
22 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
23 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
24

1 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
2 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

3 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
5 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
6 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
7 be produced upon application;

8 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
10 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
11 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
12 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
13 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
14 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
15 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
16 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
17 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
18 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
19 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
20 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
21 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

22 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
23 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
24 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars

1 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
2 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
3 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
4 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

5 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
6 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
7 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
8 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
9 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
10 of one (1) ton or less;

11 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
13 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
14 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
15 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

16 23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
17 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
18 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
19 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

20 24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
22 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
23 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
24

1 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
2 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

3 25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
5 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
6 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
7 the Ninety-Nines;

8 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
9 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
10 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
11 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
12 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
13 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
14 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
15 less;

16 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
17 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
18 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
19 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
20 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
21 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22 28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
24 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for

1 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
2 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

3 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
5 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
6 United States Secretary of Defense;

7 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
9 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
10 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
11 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
12 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
13 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

14 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
15 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
16 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
17 district number;

18 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
20 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
21 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
22 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
23 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
24 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a

1 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
2 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
3 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
4 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
5 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
6 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
8 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
9 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
10 annulment, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
11 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
12 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
13 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
14 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
15 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
16 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

17 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
18 and is also eligible for an insignia as a physically disabled person
19 under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person
20 shall be eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that
21 also displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a
22 stylized human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the
23 disabled veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the

1 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
2 the Tax Commission;

3 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
4 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
5 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
6 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
7 designed in consultation with the Association;

8 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
9 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
10 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
11 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
12 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
13 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
14 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
15 Academy;

16 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
17 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's
18 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
19 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
20 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
21 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
22 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
23 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
24 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Oklahoma

1 Tax Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
2 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
3 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
4 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
5 applications for such plates must be made to the ~~Oklahoma~~ Tax
6 Commission on or before the first day of October of any year for
7 such plates for the following calendar year and must be accompanied
8 by the fee required in this section together with a certificate, or
9 such other evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that
10 applicant has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's
11 license and proof of ~~his~~ applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which
12 radio receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants
13 shall only be entitled to one set of special identification plates
14 in any one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped
15 thereon. The right to such special identification plates herein
16 provided for shall continue until the amateur radio operator's
17 license of the person to whom such plates are issued expires or is
18 revoked;

19 36. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
21 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
22 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
23 Oklahoma;

24

1 37. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
3 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
4 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
5 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
6 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
7 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
8 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
10 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
11 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
12 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
13 state;

14 38. Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed for any resident of this state who is the surviving spouse
16 of an honorably discharged veteran who died due to or as a
17 consequence of a service-connected disability. Such surviving
18 spouse may, if not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage
19 is terminated by death, divorce or annulment, apply for a Surviving
20 Spouse license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
21 of one (1) ton or less;

22 39. Gold Star Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed to honor the surviving spouses of qualified veterans. As
24 used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran" shall mean:

1 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
2 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
3 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
4 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
5 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
6 while on active military duty, or

7 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
8 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
9 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
10 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
11 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
12 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
13 discharge of such person;

14 40. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has
16 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States
17 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
18 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
19 capacity of one (1) ton or less; and

20 41. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.
22 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide
23 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
24

1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
2 Infantry.

3 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
4 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to
5 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
6 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
7 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration

10 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
11 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
12 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
13 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
14 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
15 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
16 Columbus emblem;

17 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
18 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
19 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
20 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

1 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
2 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

3 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
4 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.

5 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
6 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
7 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
8 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
10 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
11 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
12 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
13 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
15 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
16 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
17 of the fire department.

18 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend
19 "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more
20 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.
21 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese
22 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color
23 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word
24 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for

1 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new
2 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
3 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design
4 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
5 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
6 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
8 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
9 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and
10 Living Memorial;

11 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
13 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
14 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
15 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
16 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
17 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
18 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
19 plates.

20 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
21 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
22 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
2 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
3 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
4 the prevention of child abuse.

5 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
6 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

7 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
8 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
9 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
10 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
11 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
12 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
13 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
14 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
15 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
16 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
17 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
18 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
19 issued;

20 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
22 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
23 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
24 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

1 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
3 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
5 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
6 Oklahoma;

7 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
9 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
10 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
11 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
12 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
13 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
16 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
17 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
19 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
20 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
21 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
22 collected shall be apportioned to the county of residence of the
23 person purchasing the plates to be equally apportioned by the county
24 to the city and county volunteer fire departments in the county;

1 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
3 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
4 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
5 Revolving Fund;

6 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
8 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
9 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
10 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
11 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
12 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
13 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
14 provide services to crime victims;

15 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
18 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
19 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
20 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
21 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
22 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

23 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
24 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the

1 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
2 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
3 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
4 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
5 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
6 Section 1104.4 of this title;

7 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
8 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
9 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
10 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
11 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
12 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
13 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
14 Section 1104.3 of this title;

15 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
17 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
18 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
19 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
20 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
21 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
22 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
23 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

24

1 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
4 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
6 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
7 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
8 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
9 follows:

- 10 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
11 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 12 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
13 Education Revolving Fund,
- 14 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
15 Career Technology Fund, and
- 16 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
17 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
18 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
19 Oklahoma Statutes.

20 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
21 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
22 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
23 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
24 paragraph;

1 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
3 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
4 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
5 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
6 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
7 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
8 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
9 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
10 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
11 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
12 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
13 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
14 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
15 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
16 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
17 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
18 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

19 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
21 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
22 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
23 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
24 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.

1 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
2 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
3 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
4 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
5 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
6 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
8 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
9 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
10 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
11 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
12 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
14 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
15 of this title;

16 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
18 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
19 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
20 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
21 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
22 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
23 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

24

1 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
2 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
3 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
4 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
5 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
6 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
7 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
8 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
9 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
10 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
11 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
12 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
13 specifically for created families;

14 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
15 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
16 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
17 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
18 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
19 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
20 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
21 this title;

22 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
24 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The

1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
2 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
3 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
4 Section 1104.7 of this title;

5 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
6 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
7 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
8 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
9 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
10 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
11 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
12 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
13 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
14 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
15 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
16 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

17 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
19 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
20 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
21 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
22 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
23 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
24 Section 1104.8 of this title;

1 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
2 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
3 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
4 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
5 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
6 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
7 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
8 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
9 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
10 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
11 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
12 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
13 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
14 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
15 plate issued;

16 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
18 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
19 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
20 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
21 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
22 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
23 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
24 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial

1 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
2 plate issued;

3 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
5 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
6 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
7 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

8 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
9 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
10 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
11 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
12 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
13 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
14 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
15 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

16 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
18 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
19 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
21 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
22 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
23 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
24

1 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
2 Section 1104.10 of this title;

3 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
4 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
5 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
6 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
7 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
8 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
9 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
10 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
11 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

12 33. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such
13 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation
14 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.
15 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the
16 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the
17 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
18 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this
19 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
20 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title
21 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

22 34. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
23 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
24 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma

1 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
2 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
3 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
4 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
5 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
6 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
7 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 35. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -
9 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
10 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
11 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
12 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
13 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
14 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
15 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
16 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
17 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
18 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
19 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
20 plate issued;

21 36. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall
22 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
23 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be
24 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse

1 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
2 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
3 Fund created in Section ~~3 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1074 of the~~
4 ~~2nd Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature~~ 1104.12 of this title;

5 37. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
7 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
9 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
10 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
11 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
12 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
13 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section ~~22 of Enrolled House Bill~~
14 ~~No. 2708 of the 2nd Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature~~ 1104.15
15 of this title;

16 38. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
17 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
18 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
19 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
20 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
21 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section ~~4 of Enrolled~~
22 ~~Senate Bill No. 1412 of the 2nd Session of the 50th Oklahoma~~
23 ~~Legislature~~ 1104.13 of this title;

24

1 39. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
2 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
3 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
4 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
5 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
6 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
7 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
8 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section ~~5 of Enrolled Senate~~
9 ~~Bill No. 1412 of the 2nd Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature~~
10 1104.14 of this title; and

11 40. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
14 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
15 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
16 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
17 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
18 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
19 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
20 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
21 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
22 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
23 each license plate issued; and

24

1 41. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plates - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization
4 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal
5 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and
6 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military
7 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in
8 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan.
9 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
10 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. The plate shall
11 be designed in consultation with Folds of Honor Incorporated and
12 shall contain the official Folds of Honor Incorporated logo which
13 includes the mark "Folds of Honor" across the bottom of the plate.
14 The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing
15 agreement with Folds of Honor Incorporated for any licensing fees
16 which may be required in order to use the Folds of Honor
17 Incorporated logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
18 for a payment to Folds of Honor Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars
19 (\$25.00) for each license plate issued.

20 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
21 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
22 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
23 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

1 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
2 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
3 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
4 license plate;

5 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
6 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
7 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
8 and

9 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
10 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

11 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
