8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Highway Remediation
9 and Cleanup Services Act; stating exceptions for
10 certain railroads and electric utilities; providing
11 for codification; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-7-406 of Title 27A, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Highway Remediation and
18 Cleanup Services Act shall not apply to discharges or spills from
19 rail transportation, vehicles or cargo at locations including, but
20 not limited to, highway, street or road intersections or other
21 locations involving railroad tracks.

22 B. The provisions of the Oklahoma Highway Remediation and
23 Cleanup Services Act shall not apply to discharges or spills from

1 vehicles, cargo or electrical equipment under the control of an
2 electric utility.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
