9 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.  
10 2001, Section 150.23, as last amended by Section 3,  
11 Chapter 169, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section  
12 150.23), which relates to authority of retired state  
13 employees to retain possession of certain sidearms  
14 and badges; authorizing certain retired Office of  
15 Inspector General and Department of Human Services  
16 employees retain possession of sidearms and badges;  
17 and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 150.23, as  
20 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 169, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp.  
21 2009, Section 150.23), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 150.23 A. An officer, investigator, or agent of the  
23 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
24 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Department of Wildlife  
Conservation, the Law Enforcement Division of the Oklahoma Horse  
Racing Commission, the State Fire Marshal's Office, the Oklahoma  
Tourism and Recreation Department, the Office of Inspector General

1 and the Oklahoma Child Support Services divisions of the Department  
2 of Human Services or the office of a district attorney shall be  
3 entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of length of service,  
4 the continued custody and possession of the sidearm and badge  
5 carried by such officer, investigator, or agent immediately prior to  
6 retirement.

7 B. An officer, investigator, or agent specified in subsection A  
8 of this section may be entitled to receive, upon retirement by  
9 reason of disability, the continued custody and possession of the  
10 sidearm and badge carried by such officer or agent immediately prior  
11 to retirement upon written approval of the applicable Director of  
12 the appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or district  
13 attorney.

14 C. Custody and possession of the sidearm and badge of an  
15 officer, investigator, or agent who dies while employed by any  
16 Bureau, Department, Commission, or office specified in subsection A  
17 of this section may be awarded by the applicable Director of the  
18 appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or office to the spouse  
19 or ~~next of kin~~ next of kin of the deceased officer, investigator, or  
20 agent.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
