11 3904 and 3905), which relate to the termination of
12 certain statutory entities; re-creating certain
13 entities; modifying list of statutory entities
14 subject to re-creation; and modifying termination
15 date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3904, as
18 amended by Section 1, Chapter 26, O.S.L. 2003 (74 O.S. Supp. 2008,
19 Section 3904), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 3904. The following statutory entities and their
21 successors shall be terminated on July 1, ~~2009~~ 2013, and all powers,
22 duties and functions shall be abolished one (1) year thereafter:
