8 An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.
9 2001, Section 10-112, as last amended by Section 2,
10 Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2008 (11 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section
11 10-112), which relates to the appointment of city
12 manager; modifying certain residency requirement for
13 city manager; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 10-112, as
16 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2008 (11 O.S. Supp.
17 2008, Section 10-112), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 10-112. The council shall appoint a city manager or a
19 part-time city manager, pursuant to this act, by a vote of a
20 majority of all its members subject to the terms of employment
21 established by the council. It shall choose the city manager or
22 part-time city manager solely on the basis of executive and
23 administrative qualifications with special reference to the actual
24 experience in, or the knowledge of, accepted practice in respect to

1 the duties of the office. ~~At the time of appointment, the city~~
2 ~~manager need not be a resident of the city or state; but during the~~
3 ~~tenure of holding office the city manager shall reside within the~~
4 ~~city.~~ City managers or part-time city managers may appoint
5 themselves, or the council or other authority may appoint or elect
6 the city manager or part-time city manager, to other offices and
7 positions in the city government, subject to regulations prescribed
8 by ordinance; but the city manager or part-time city manager may not
9 receive compensation for service in such other offices or positions.
10 Neither the mayor nor any members of the city council may be
11 appointed city manager or part-time city manager during the term for
12 which they shall have been elected nor within two (2) years after
13 they cease to hold such office.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
