8 An Act relating to schools; amending Section 14,  
9 Chapter 375, O.S.L. 2003 (70 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section  
10 821.94), which relates to athlete agents; expanding  
11 list of prohibited acts to include certain  
12 communication with student-athletes; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 14, Chapter 375, O.S.L.  
16 2003 (70 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 821.94), is amended to read as  
17 follows:

18 Section 821.94 A. An athlete agent, with the intent to induce  
19 a student-athlete to enter into an agency contract, shall not:

20 1. Give any materially false or misleading information or make  
21 a materially false promise or representation;

22 2. Furnish anything of value to a student-athlete before the  
23 student-athlete enters into the agency contract; or

1 3. Furnish anything of value to any individual other than the  
2 student-athlete or another registered athlete agent.

3 B. An athlete agent shall not intentionally:

4 1. Initiate contact with a student-athlete unless the athlete  
5 agent registered pursuant to the Uniform Athlete Agents Act;

6 2. Refuse or fail to retain or permit inspection of the records  
7 required to be retained by Section ~~13~~ 821.93 of this ~~act~~ title;

8 3. Fail to register when required by Section ~~4~~ 821.84 of this  
9 ~~act~~ title;

10 4. Provide materially false or misleading information in an  
11 application for registration or renewal of registration;

12 5. Predate or postdate an agency contract; or

13 6. Fail to notify a student-athlete before the student-athlete  
14 signs or otherwise authenticates an agency contract for a particular  
15 sport that the signing or authentication may make the student-  
16 athlete ineligible to participate as a student-athlete in that  
17 sport.

18 C. An athlete agent is prohibited from any and all  
19 communication with student-athletes who are ineligible to be  
20 drafted, with the exception of general promotional brochures.

21 Communication includes, but is not limited to in-person contact,  
22 telephonic and electronic communication.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
