BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 85.43, is amended to read as follows:

Section 85.43 A. Each chief administrative officer of a state agency shall submit to the State Purchasing Director by November 1 of each year a report listing all acquisitions exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) but not exceeding Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) of the state agency for the preceding fiscal year which will include the following information:

1. Professional services contracts;
2. Nonprofessional services contracts; and

1 3. Contracts for the leasing of property including real
2 property contracts and any lease agreements for products or
3 equipment.

4 B. The report shall contain:

5 1. The name of the supplier;

6 2. A description of each acquisition;

7 3. The purchase price of the acquisition; and

8 4. The total amount expended to date for the preceding fiscal
9 year for the acquisition.

10 C. The report shall specifically identify sole source and sole
11 brand acquisitions.

12 D. The state agency shall submit the report, in written or
13 electronic format, to the State Auditor and Inspector and to the
14 Department of Central Services. The state agency shall submit the
15 report, in written or electronic format, to any member of the
16 Appropriations and Budget Committee of the House of Representatives
17 or Appropriations Committee of the Senate if a member so requests.

18 E. The State Auditor and Inspector shall review the report for
19 compliance with statutes and rules or other provisions of law
20 applicable to sole source and sole brand acquisitions.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2009.
