14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
16 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
17 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
18 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
19 so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of
20 public schools.

21 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
22 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
23 Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 41.29b of Title
24 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum of _____ Dollars

1 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial
2 support of public schools.

3 SECTION 3. The State Board of Education is hereby authorized to
4 expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, from the Common
5 Education Technology Revolving Fund of the State Treasury, the sum
6 of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary for the financial support of public schools.

8 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
9 Education, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
10 Mineral Leasing Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
11 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public

4 SECTION 14. The funds appropriated in Section 10 of this act in

7 SECTION 15. The funds appropriated in Section 11 of this act in
8 the amount of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be transferred to
9 the Teachers' Retirement System Dedicated Revenue Revolving Fund.

10 SECTION 16. Funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
11 Parent Training Program, Advanced Placement Incentives, Middle
12 School Mathematics Laboratories, Community Education and the
13 Robotics Program shall be made available on a statewide competitive
14 application basis as specified.

15 SECTION 17. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act

3 2. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be
4 transferred to the Oklahoma National Board Certification Revolving
5 Fund created in Section 6-204.4 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes
6 for the purpose of awarding annual bonuses as directed; and

7 3. _____ Dollars (0.00) shall be
8 transferred to the Oklahoma School Psychologist, Speech-Language
9 Pathologist, and Audiologist National Certification Revolving Fund
10 created in Section 6-206.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes for
11 the purpose of awarding annual bonuses as directed.

12 The remaining funds in the Education Leadership Oklahoma

23 institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education

3 2. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be transferred
4 to the Professional Development Institutes Revolving Fund created in
5 Section 6-204.5 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and shall be
6 expended for the purpose of developing, offering and administering
7 professional development institutes in reading for elementary school
8 teachers as directed in Section 6-200 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma
9 Statutes. Of these funds, the sum of _____ Dollars
10 (\$0.00) shall be expended for the purpose of funding grants for
11 schoolwide professional development to implement comprehensive
12 reading reform and systemic change pursuant to subsection D of
13 Section 6-200 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 3. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) for costs
15 associated with multiple ongoing assessments and remediation
16 pursuant to the provisions of Section 1210.508D of Title 70 of the
17 Oklahoma Statutes;

18 4. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) for a
19 comprehensive professional development program for teachers and
20 other school personnel on neurodevelopmentally-based student
21 learning differences. The program shall provide research-based
22 knowledge and skills training to help educators recognize,
23 understand and manage students with differences in learning. The

1 Board shall select a public, private, or nonprofit provider on a
2 competitive-bid basis to conduct the program;

3 5. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) to continue
4 research-based professional development for teachers through the
5 Oklahoma Technical Assistance Center;

6 6. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) for the
7 purpose of expanding the number of elementary schools which utilize
8 the Oklahoma A+ Schools Art Program offered through an institution
9 within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education;

10 7. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) for the
11 purpose of implementing the Oklahoma Mathematics Improvement Program
12 established pursuant to the provisions of Section 6-207 of Title 70
13 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

14 8. Any remainder shall be allocated on an average daily
15 attendance basis for the purpose of teacher education and staff
16 development pursuant to rules promulgated by the State Board of
17 Education. Not more than five percent (5%) of the funds allocated
18 by average daily attendance for Staff Development may be used by
19 local districts for the administration of the staff development
20 program.

21 SECTION 20. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
22 Alternative and High Challenge Education shall be expended for the
23 purpose of operating the statewide system of alternative education
24 programs as provided in Section 1210.568 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma

1 Statutes, and for encouraging school districts to participate in
2 innovative alternative education programs. The funds shall be
3 expended as follows:

4 1. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) for programs;

5 2. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) for program

6 evaluation, technical assistance and staff development conducted by
7 the technical assistance provider contracted as provided for in
8 Section 1210.568 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

9 3. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) for an arts

10 component;

11 4. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) for a Truancy

12 Diversion Program in a large urban county selected by the State
13 Department of Education;

14 5. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) for the salaries,

15 benefits and administrative costs incurred by the State Board of
16 Education in administering the Alternative Education Programs and
17 Alternative Academies; and

18 6. Any remaining funds shall be provided to school districts on
19 a competitive application basis pursuant to the rules promulgated by
20 the State Board of Education. Salary increases provided to
21 certified or noncertified personnel within a school district shall
22 be made without a reduction in the services provided or number of
23 students served in the district's alternative education statewide
24 academy programs.

1 SECTION 21. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
2 Early Intervention shall be transferred to the fund designated
3 within the Office of State Finance as the Early Intervention Fund
4 250. It is the intent of the Legislature that funding available for
5 SoonerStart Early Intervention Services be expended for direct
6 services to eligible infants, toddlers and their families. The
7 State Department of Education shall not contract, pay or reimburse
8 for administrative cost recovery personnel, accounting, and
9 management information system costs, maintenance and operations at
10 the state or local level or indirect costs which do not comply with
11 the requirements of Section 13-125 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma
12 Statutes.

13 SECTION 22. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
14 ACE Remediation shall be allocated by the State Department of
15 Education to school districts for the purpose of funding school
16 districts on a per-hour per-student basis for the costs associated
17 with providing remediation to students pursuant to the provisions of
18 Section 1210.522 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The State
19 Board of Education shall determine the per-hour per-student dollar
20 amount to be allocated to school districts.

21 SECTION 23. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
22 the Early Childhood Initiative shall be expended for the purpose of
23 funding the early childhood program pursuant to the provisions of
24 Section 10-105.4 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 SECTION 24. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
2 the Parent Training Program, as authorized in Section 10-105.3 of
3 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be expended as follows:

4 1. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be expended
5 for the salaries, benefits, technical assistance and administrative
6 costs incurred by the State Board of Education in contracting for
7 technical assistance in field operations for the coordination of the
8 Oklahoma Parents as Teachers Program;

9 2. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be
10 expended for the continuation and expansion of the Oklahoma Parents
11 as Teachers Program;

12 3. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be
13 expended for program evaluation conducted by the Oklahoma Technical
14 Assistance Center;

15 4. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be
16 expended for the establishment of the Oklahoma Parents as Teachers
17 Program in public housing projects; and

18 5. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be
19 expended for the early childhood technical assistance and field
20 operations provided by the State Department of Education.

21 SECTION 25. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
22 the Advanced Placement Incentives shall be expended for one-time
23 equipment or materials, grants, subsidized training, school
24 incentives, exam fee reimbursement, and administrative costs. The

1 amount of funds expended for administrative costs shall not exceed
2 _____ Dollars (\$0.00).

3 SECTION 26. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
4 Middle School Mathematics Laboratories shall be expended for the
5 purpose of funding Middle School Mathematics Laboratories
6 established pursuant to the provisions of Section 1210.558 of Title
7 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

8 SECTION 27. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
9 Academic Achievement Awards shall be expended for the purpose of
10 funding awards pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-152.1 of
11 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 SECTION 28. The funds allocated for the Rural Infant
13 Stimulation Environment (RISE) Program in Section 12 of this act
14 shall be used for capital expenditures and operations for a school
15 designed to serve children with disabilities from birth to five (5)
16 years of age.

17 SECTION 29. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
18 Instructional, Cooperative and Technological Education shall be
19 apportioned as follows:

20 1. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be expended on a
21 contractual basis to the Chickasha Public School District (26-I-001)
22 for the purpose of room and board payments for students at the Jane
23 Brooks School for the Deaf, pursuant to contracts between the
24 Chickasha School District and the Jane Brooks School for the Deaf;

1 2. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be expended on
2 a contractual basis for the Oklahoma Science and Engineering Fair;

3 3. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be awarded to
4 independent school districts which meet the average daily attendance
5 required to obtain a small school incentive grant pursuant to the
6 provisions of Section 18-125 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes
7 for costs incurred for expanding the number of grades;

8 4. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be awarded to a
9 nonprofit arts center located in Oklahoma that has been selected by
10 the John F. Kennedy Performing Arts Center for a Special Educator
11 Professional Development Program. The State Board of Education
12 shall give priority to any arts center which received funding the
13 preceding year if the operations of the arts center are deemed
14 satisfactory by the Board; and

15 5. _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be awarded to a
16 science center located in Oklahoma that provides science
17 education classes, science laboratories, and science
18 demonstrations to public school students, in addition to outreach
19 and teacher professional development for science teachers.

20 SECTION 30. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
21 the Robotics Program shall be expended for the purpose of funding
22 _____ (0.0) grants to school districts in the amount of
23 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) each to establish a robotics project in
24 the school districts. Each robotics project shall involve creation

1 of teams of students who with the assistance of teachers and
2 volunteers design and build a remote-controlled robot that is
3 entered into regional- and national-level robotics competitions.
4 The State Board of Education shall determine grant eligibility
5 criteria, solicit proposals, and establish a process for the
6 consideration of proposals. Proposals shall be considered on a
7 statewide competitive basis.

8 SECTION 31. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
9 the Charter Schools Incentive Fund shall be transferred to the
10 Charter Schools Incentive Fund for use pursuant to the provisions of
11 Section 3-144 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 SECTION 32. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
13 Community Education Grants shall be awarded on a contractual basis
14 to a community education consortium group which is associated with
15 an institution in The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, for
16 the purpose of providing coordination services for community
17 education programs, providing statistical data and information about
18 community education programs to the State Board of Education and to
19 enhance accountability of community education programs.

20 SECTION 33. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
21 Recreation Therapy Grants shall be awarded as one or more grants to
22 school districts offering recreation therapy for children with
23 special needs. Priority shall be given to schools who have
24 implemented such a program and shown progress under the program.

1 SECTION 34. The funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
2 the Oklahoma Ambassador of Teaching shall be expended to enhance the
3 Teacher of the Year Program and to assist the Teacher of the Year in
4 acting as an ambassador for teaching.

5 SECTION 35. The amount of _____ Dollars
6 (\$0.00) of the funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
7 Administrative and Support Functions of the State Department of
8 Education shall be expended for continued implementation of the
9 Oklahoma Cost Accounting System.

10 SECTION 36. The amount of _____ Dollars
11 (0.00) of the funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
12 Administrative and Support Functions of the State Department of
13 Education shall be expended to ensure school district participation
14 in the National Assessment of Educational Progress.

15 SECTION 37. The amount of _____ Dollars
16 (\$0.00) of the funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
17 Administrative and Support Functions of the State Department of
18 Education shall be expended for contracting with the Oklahoma
19 Alliance for Geographic Education to provide in-service training and
20 material for geography instruction.

21 SECTION 38. The amount of _____ Dollars
22 (\$0.00) of the funds allocated in Section 12 of this act for
23 Administrative and Support Functions of the State Department of
24 Education shall be expended for reimbursement of costs associated

1 with the eighth-grade reading level proficiency test administered
2 pursuant to the provisions of Section 1210.515 of Title 70 of the
3 Oklahoma Statutes.

4 SECTION 39. Of the funds allocated in Section 12 of this act
5 for Administrative and Support Functions of the State Department of
6 Education, the sum of _____ Dollars
7 (\$0.00) shall be expended for North Central Accreditation. The
8 amount of funding shall be sufficient to fund a minimum of four (4)
9 full-time-equivalent employees, to provide office space, to support
10 all of the daily operations of the office, and to allow the office
11 to fully function and perform its duties during the fiscal year
12 ending June 30, 2010. North Central Subvention Funds shall not be
13 used for employee salaries.

14 SECTION 40. Of the funds allocated in Section 12 of this act
15 for Administrative and Support Functions of the State Department of
16 Education, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
17 shall be expended for the purpose of implementing a student
18 identification system pursuant to the provisions of Section 18-200.1
19 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

20 SECTION 41. Of the funds allocated in Section 12 of this act
21 for Administrative and Support Functions of the State Department of
22 Education, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be
23 expended for the purpose of providing training for local district
24

1 school board members pursuant to the provisions of Sections 5-110
2 and 5-110.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 42. Of the funds allocated in Section 12 of this act
4 for Administrative and Support Functions of the State Department of
5 Education, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be
6 expended for the purpose of implementing pilot character education
7 programs pursuant to the provisions of Section 1210.229-6 of Title
8 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

9 SECTION 43. Of the funds allocated in Section 12 of this act
10 for Administrative and Support Functions of the State Department of
11 Education, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall
12 be expended to contract with the Council for Economic Education for
13 the purpose of implementing the provisions of Section 11-103.6h of
14 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

15 SECTION 44. The State Department of Education is authorized to
16 expend up to _____ Dollars (\$0.00) of the funds
17 allocated in Section 12 of this act for Administrative and Support
18 Functions of the State Department of Education to establish a pilot
19 project to extend reading opportunities in grades kindergarten
20 through third.

21 SECTION 45. The duties and compensation of employees, not
22 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
23 upon the State Department of Education by law shall be set by the
24 State Board of Education. The State Department of Education for the

1 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following
2 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
3 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
4 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
5 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

12 Superintendent of Public Instruction shall file a report with the
13 Education Oversight Board on the Oklahoma Early Intervention
14 Program.

15 SECTION 47. Of the _____ (0.0) full-time-equivalent
16 employees authorized in Section 45 of this act, _____ (0.0)
17 shall be designated for the Parent Training Program as funded in
18 Section 12 of this act.

19 SECTION 48. Of the _____ (0.0) full-time-equivalent
20 employees authorized in Section 45 of this act, _____ (0.0)
21 shall be employed to provide services pursuant to the provisions of
22 the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act.

23 SECTION 49. Of the _____ (0.0) full-time-equivalent
24 employees authorized in Section 45 of this act, _____ (0.0) shall

1 be designated as coordinator of support personnel concerns.
2 Responsibilities of the coordinator shall include acting as liaison
3 with the Legislature, with organizations representing support
4 personnel, and with the State Board of Education, and disseminating
5 information to support personnel, including, but not limited to,
6 retirement information.

7 SECTION 50. Of the _____ (0.0) full-time-equivalent
8 employees authorized in Section 45 of this act, _____ (0.0)
9 shall be designated for the State Aid Section of the Financial
10 Services Division of the State Department of Education.

11 SECTION 51. State Aid funds shall be reduced or withheld by the
12 State Board of Education in an amount necessary to ensure compliance
13 with the provisions of this act.

14 SECTION 52. The State Board of Education is authorized to
15 request the Office of State Finance to transfer appropriated funds
16 to the appropriate dispensing fund.

17 SECTION 53. If funds appropriated in this act are not
18 sufficient to fully fund the provisions of this act, each school
19 district which qualifies for funds, excluding Financial Support of
20 Public Schools, pursuant to the provisions of this act shall take a
21 proportionate reduction.

22 SECTION 54. Appropriations made by this act, not including
23 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be

1 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
2 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
3 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
4 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
5 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
6 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
7 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
8 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
9 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
10 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
11 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
12 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
13 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
14 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
15 approved by the Office of State Finance.

16 SECTION 55. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

17 SECTION 56. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
